KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, for and in consideration of **Seven Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand and 00/100 (\$725,000.00)**, and other good and valuable consideration, this day in hand paid to the undersigned **Birmingham-Southern College, an Alabama non-profit corporation** (hereinafter referred to as GRANTOR), in hand paid by the GRANTEEES herein, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the GRANTOR does hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the GRANTEEES, **J.Don Williams and Jane B. Williams**, (hereinafter referred to as GRANTEEES), for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described Real Estate, lying and being in the County of **Shelby**, State of Alabama, to-wit:

Lot 119-A, according to a Resurvey of Lots 114, 118, 119, 120, 129, 130, 137, 138 and 143, Shoal Creek, as recorded in Map Book 7, page 20, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

Subject To:


Ad valorem taxes for 2001 and subsequent years not yet due and payable until October 1, 2001. Existing covenants and restrictions, easements, building lines and limitations of record.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the tract or parcel of land above described together with all and singular the rights, privileges, tenements, appurtenances, and improvements unto the said GRANTEE'S, for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, and to the heirs and assigns of such survivor, forever.

AND SAID GRANTOR, for said GRANTOR, GRANTOR'S heirs, successors, executors and administrators, covenants with GRANTEEES, and with GRANTEEES' heirs and assigns, that GRANTOR is lawfully seized in fee simple of the said Real Estate; that said Real Estate is free and clear from all Liens and Encumbrances, except as hereinabove set forth, and except for taxes due for the current and subsequent years, and except for any Restrictions pertaining to the Real Estate of record in the Probate Office of said County; and that GRANTOR will, and GRANTOR'S heirs, executors and administrators shall, warrant and defend the same to said GRANTEEES, and GRANTEEES' heirs and assigns, forever against the lawful claims of all persons.


