WARRANTY DEED, JOINTLY FOR LIFE WITH REMAINDER TO SURVIVOR

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

COUNTY OF SHELBY)

THAT IN CONSIDERATION OF Three Hundred Thirty-eight Thousand Dollars and NO/100 (\$338,000.00) and other good and valuable consideration to the undersigned Grantors in hand paid by the Grantees herein, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, David A. Otto and his wife, Patricia S. Otto, (herein referred to as Grantors, whether one or more) do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto David D. Chaplin and his wife, Jane Chaplin, (herein referred to as Grantees, whether one or more), as joint tenants, with right of survivorship, the following described real estate, situated in the State of Alabama, County of Shelby, to-wit:

Lot 22, according to the Survey of Wildwood Park, as recorded in Map Book 5, page 78, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

Subject to:


- 1. Existing easements, restrictions, current taxes, set-back lines, rights of way, limitations, if any, of record.


NOTE: \$270,400.00 of the above consideration was paid from the proceeds of a mortgage filed simultaneously herewith.
