JUDGMENT

The Court having been advised by the parties that a settlement of this case has been reached through mediation, and in accordance with the agreement of the parties it is hereby ORDER, AJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

The Plaintiff, First Commercial Bank is hereby awarded a final nondischargeable

Judgment against the Defendant Darrell V. Jones in the amount of \$30,162.68. Said Judgment

will bear interest at the applicable Treasury Bill rate from the date of entry of this Judgment.

The Plaintiff may request Certificates of Judgment and record those Certificates in any county it

chooses upon entry of this Judgment.

Darrell V. Jones may satisfy the final nondischargeable Judgment by paying First Commercial Bank three thousand (\$3,000.00) no later than August 1, 2001, and an additional twelve thousand (\$12,000.00) no later than January 5, 2002. Payments must be received no later

than the close of business on each applicable due date.

In the event of a default (the failure to pay either installment on its applicable due date) the full unpaid balance on the \$30,162.38 nondischargeable Judgment will be immediately due and payable. That is, should Darrell Jones not pay either installment the entire Judgment amount will be due First Commercial, minus any sums already paid.

This Judgment supercedes, replaces, and is in lieu of that certain Judgment entered against Darrell V. Jones and in favor of First Commercial Bank in the Circuit Court of Jefferson County, in case number, CV-1999-3623-TMS.

There being no just reason for delay, the Judgment is entered as a final judgment pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 7054(b).

Costs are to be taxed to the Defendant.
