Article The total number of shareholder votes entitled to be cast is ..0. The number of shareholder votes for the dissolution was N/A * and the votes against the dissolution was N/A.

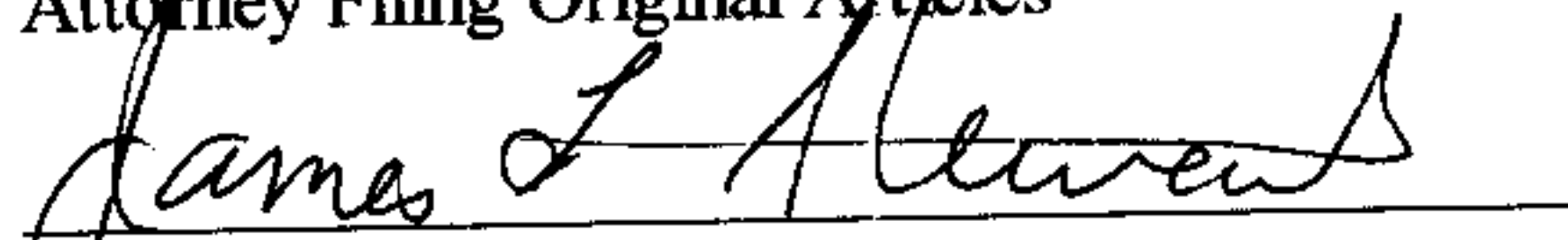
Article IV If voting by groups, the information required by Article III above must be separately provided for each group entitled to vote.
