AFFIDAVIT

My father was John H. Smith from Montevallo, who owned the following described property, to-wit:



The property described is the same property described as "The house and lot on Selma Street, in Montevallo, Alabama, now occupied by him as a residence", as shown in Item 4, of the Last Will and Testament of Hampton D. Lee. I have never known of any one other than John H. Smith and his heirs at law being in possession of the property, nor do I know of any parties other than the heirs of John H. Smith making a claim to the property.


