My name is Robert C. Farmer and I am a registered surveyor in the State of Alabama. I am personally familiar with the subdivision now known as High Ridge Village, Phase 1 as recorded in Map Book 27, page 140 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama also situated in the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25, Township 20 South, Range 3 West, City of Pelham, Shelby County, Alabama.
