## ORDER ON FILING REPORT OF COMMISSIONERS

#### ORDER CLARIFYING PREVIOUS ORDER

This matter came before the Court on Motion for Clarification of Order filed by Charles L. Warren and Peggy S. Warren, defendants. Upon consideration of said motion, the Court amends its ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINT AND APPOINTING COMMISSIONERS as follows:

- 1) Defendants' motion to dismiss Plaintiff's complaint, which was taken under advisement, is DENIED.
- 2) Plaintiff's <u>Application for Acquisition of Right of Way</u> is granted as to property of defendants described in Plaintiff's Exhibit 1 (survey and legal description) submitted at the trial of this matter, particularly described as follows:

From a 2" pipe accepted as the N.E. corner of the SWI/4 - NWI/4 of Section 19, T20S-RIE, being the point of beginning of herein described 30' easement for ingress and egress, run thence South along the accepted East boundary of said SWI/4-NWI/4 a distance of 30.03 feet; thence turn 87°30' 09" right and run 8.69 feet to the P.C. of a curve concave right, having a Delta angle of 76°29'31" and tangents of 90.00 feet; thence turn 38° 14'46" right and run a chord distance of 141.36 feet to the P.T.; thence turn 38° 14' 46" right and run 170.60

feet to the P.C. of a curve concave left, having a Delta angle of 68° 08'02" and tangents of 60.00 feet; thence turn 34° 04' 01" left and run a chord distance of 99.41 feet to the P.T.; thence turn 34° 04'01"left and run 40.00 feet to a point on the East boundary of Shelby County Highway #49 (80' R.O.W.); thence turn 90° 00' 00" right and run 30.00 feet along said Highway boundary; thence turn 90° 00' 00" right and run 40.00 feet to the P.C. of a curve concave right; having a Delta angle of 68° 08' 02" and tangents of 80.29 feet; thence turn 34° 04' 01" right and run a chord distance of 133.02 feet to the P.T.; thence turn 34° 04' 01" right and run 170.60 feet to the P.C. of a curve concave left, having a Delta angle of 76° 29' 31"and tangents of 66.35 feet; thence turn 38° 14' 46" left and run a chord distance of 104.22 feet to the P.T.; thence turn 38° 14' 46" left and run 10.00 feet to the point of beginning of herein described 30' easement.

#### **AMENDED**

#### ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINT AND APPOINTING COMMISSIONERS
