PETITION: REAL PROPERTY

TO ONE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT JUDGES OF THE EIGHTEENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT OF ALABAMA

COMES NOW the State of Alabama, by William H. Bostick, Assistant District Attorney of the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit of Alabama, who prosecutes for the State in its behalf and shows to this Honorable Court the following state of facts, to-wit:

- That on, to-wit: June 28, 2001, at to-wit: 1517 Radburn Drive, Pelham, Shelby County, Alabama, and in the jurisdiction of this Court, Officer(s) Davy Lott and Bobby Smith of the Pelham Police Department while in the discharge of their duties as such officer(s) did then and there seize a certain property, to-wit: (See attached Exhibit "A"), said property is now in the custody of the Pelham Police Department who holds said property subject to the orders and decrees of this Court.
- Petitioner further avers that prior to the time of said seizure, to-wit: June 28, 2001, 2. at to-wit: 1517 Radburn Drive, Pelham, Shelby County, Alabama, said property was being used by or within the immediate proximity of the aforesaid Respondent(s) Roger Dale Motes, who is believed to have had the intent to use said property to facilitate the violation of the controlled substance laws of the State of Alabama and/or is considered to be proceeds from the illegal sale of (a) controlled substance(s) contrary to and in violation of Section 20-2-93, Code of Alabama, 1975.

- That the above seizure of property arose from an investigation of Roger Dale Motes and reported illegal drug activity from his residence at 1517 Radburn Drive, Pelham, Shelby County, Alabama. Further, that a number of controlled drug sales were conducted and recorded at the residence of Roger Dale Motes.
