1. The name of the corporation is Orbix Technology, Inc.
2. The aggregate number of shares of capital stock which the corporation shall have authority to issue is 10,000 shares of common stock, par value \$0.05 per share.
3. The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 522 Creekside Court, Helena, Alabama 35080, and the name of its initial registered agent at that office is Shannon Scott.

10. The corporation reserves the right by majority vote to amend or repeal any provision of these articles of incorporation in the manner provided by law; and all rights conferred upon the officers, directors, and shareholders of the corporation are granted subject to this reservation.
