CONSENT JUDGMENT


The Plaintiff and the Defendant, having made the Court aware of the fact that on February 29, 2000, they had agreed to a consent judgment in the amount of \$150,000.00 in favor of the Defendant on the Counterclaim filed by the Defendant against the Plaintiff, and request that this Court enter this Order in this form, and the Court having found that this Order now disposes of all issues and claims remaining between all parties in this action, it is hereby

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED as follows:

1. Judgment is hereby entered in favor of the Defendant, American United Life Insurance Company ("AUL") on its Counterclaim against the Plaintiff, Ed Robinson, in the sum of One Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars ("\$150,000.00"). Costs of this action are taxed against the Plaintiff.
