WARRANTY DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That in consideration of Two Hundred Eighteen Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$218,000.00), in hand paid to the undersigned, Danny M. Mays and wife, Julie Annette Scrushy Mays, (hereinafter referred to as the "Grantor") by Maxwell D. Bahos and wife, Nancy W. Bahos (hereinafter referred to as the "Grantee"), the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Grantor does, by these presents, grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto the Grantee as joint tenants with right of survivorship, the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:

**Lot 37, according to the Survey of Cobblestone Square as recorded in Map Book 16, Page 153, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama; being situated in Shelby County, Alabama.**

Julie Annette Scrushy and Julie Annette Scrushy Mays are one and the same person.

SUBJECT TO:

1. Ad valorem taxes due and payable October 1, 2002.
2. All restrictions, easements, Rights of parties in possession, encroachments, liens for services, labor, or materials, taxes or special assessments, building lines.
3. Easements, Encroachments, rights of ways, building set back lines, as shown on recorded plat.

\$174,400.00 and \$21,800.00 of the purchase price was paid from a mortgage loan closed simultaneously with delivery of this deed.


TO HAVE AND TO HOLD unto the said Grantees, as joint tenants, with right of survivorship, their heirs and assigns, forever; it being the intention of the parties to this conveyance, that (unless the joint tenancy hereby created is severed or terminated during the joint lives of the grantees herein) in the event one grantee herein survives the other, the entire interest in fee simple shall pass to the surviving grantee, and if one does not survive the other, then the heirs and assigns of the grantees herein shall take as tenants in common.

And I(we) do for myself (ourselves), and for my (our) heirs, executors, and administrators covenant with the Grantees, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, that I am (we are) lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises, that they are free from all encumbrances except as aforesaid, that I (we) have good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid, and that I (we) will, and my (our) successors and assigns shall warrant and defend the same to the Grantees, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, against the lawful claims of all persons.


