**WARRANTY DEED AND LIMITED POWER OF ATTORNEY**

**KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:** That in consideration of One Hundred  
Ninty-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars and no/100 -----(\$199,900.00 ) to  
the undersigned Grantors in hand paid by the Grantees, whether one or more, herein, the receipt  
of which is hereby acknowledged, we, **Alan R. Bigham and wife, Susan C. Bigham** (herein  
referred to as Grantors) do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto  
Gerald L. Johnson and wife, Annette B. Johnson (herein referred to as  
Grantees) as individual owner or as joint tenants, with right of survivorship, if more than one, the  
following described real estate, situated in the State of Alabama, County of Shelby, to-wit:

Lot 7, in Block 4, according to the Survey of Norwick Forest, Second Sector, as  
recorded in Map Book 13, Page 23 A & B, in the Probate Office of Shelby  
county, Alabama; being situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

Subject to existing easements, restrictions, set back lines, rights of ways, limitations, if any, of  
record.

\$ 0.00 of the purchase price recited above was paid from a mortgage loan closed  
simultaneously herewith.

**TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** unto the said Grantee(s), his/her/their heirs and assigns,  
forever; it being the intention of the parties to this conveyance, that if more than one Grantee,  
then to the Grantees as joint tenants with right of survivorship (unless the joint tenancy hereby  
created is severed or terminated during the joint lives of the Grantee(s) herein) in the event one  
Grantee herein survives the other, the entire interest in fee simple shall pass to the surviving  
Grantee and if one does not survive the other, then the heirs and assigns of the Grantees herein  
shall take as tenants in common.


And we do for ourselves and for our heirs, executors, and administrators covenant with

premises; that they are free from all encumbrances, unless otherwise noted above; that we have a  
good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid; that we will and my heirs, executors and  
administrators shall, warrant and defend the same to the said Grantee(s), his/her/their heirs, and  
assigns forever, against the lawful claims of all persons.

And we do by these presents make, constitute and appoint **Cendant Mobility Services,  
Inc.** ("Agent") and/or its authorized and designated agents or representatives, as our true and  
lawful agent and attorney-in-fact to do and perform for us in our name, place and stead, and for  
our use and benefit, to execute a standard form lien waiver and any and all documents necessary  
for delivery of this deed (including the dating of this deed as of the date of actual closing) and to  
complete the sale of the property herein described, including but not limited to the HUD-1  
Settlement Statement, HUD-1 Certification, Affidavit of Purchaser and Seller, AHFA Bond

Forms (Seller Affidavit), Lender Assumption Statements and/or Modification Agreement, Lender Compliance Agreement, and any other documents required for said sale and conveyance. We further give and grant unto our Agent full power and authority to do and perform every act necessary and proper to be done and the exercise of any of the foregoing powers as fully as we might or could do if personally present, with full power of substitution and revocation, hereby ratifying and confirming all that our Agent shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue hereof. This power of attorney shall not be affected by disability, incompetency or incapacity of Principal, and shall be governed by the laws of the State of Alabama. This power of attorney is coupled with an interest and shall remain in force and effect until delivery of this deed and the sale closed, and shall not be revoked by either of the undersigned prior to said time.
