

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

OF

I, Henry M. Schrader, a resident citizen of Mobile County, Alabama, over the age of twenty-one (21) years, and of sound mind and memory, do make, publish and declare this to be MY LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT, hereby revoking all former wills or codicils heretofore made by me.

ARTICLE ONE

I direct that my Executrix hereinafter named, as soon as practicable after my death, pay all just debts of mine, the cost of the administration of my estate, my funeral expenses, including any expenses incurred as a result of my last illness, and further, at the expense of my estate, provide a monument to perpetuate my memory in the minds of my family and friends.

ARTICLE TWO

I hereby give, devise and bequeath unto my wife, Aleen P. Schrader, all of my property, whether real, personal or mixed, of whatsoever kind or nature and wheresoever situated of which I may die possessed or to which I am or may be entitled to possess at the time of my death, for her to have and to hold as her property absolutely in fee simple forever.

ARTICLE THREE

I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my wife, Aleen P. Schrader, as sole Executrix of this my LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT, and I exempt her from giving any bond or security to qualify to act as such Executrix. I do further exempt her from making any inventory or report of final settlement of the administration of my estate to any court whatsoever. I fully authorize and empower my said Executrix to do all things necessary for the complete administration of my estate, to compromise, adjust and otherwise settle all claims, debts, charges or demands against or in favor of my estate as fully as I could do if living.

In the event my wife, Aleen P. Schrader, should predecease me, or death

come to us by common disaster where my wife does not survive me for a period of more than thirty (30) days, it is my WILL that these subsequent provisions of my WILL be in force and effect, otherwise to remain null and void.

ARTICLE FOUR

I direct my Executor hereinafter named, as soon as practicable after my death, pay all just debts of mine, the cost of the administration of my estate, my funeral expenses, including any expenses incurred as a result of my last illness, and further, at the expense of my estate, provide a monument to perpetuate my memory in the mind of my family and friends.

ARTICLE FIVE

I hereby give, devise and bequeath unto my children, Samuel Michael Schrader and Henry Dale Schrader, all of the property which I may own at the time of my death, whether real, personal or mixed, tangible and intangible, of whatsoever kind or nature and wheresoever situated, including all property which I may acquire or become entitled to after the execution of this WILL; including all lapsed legacies and devises, for them to have and to hold as their property share and share alike equally, absolutely and in fee simple forever.

In the event that either of my children, herein named should predecease me, leaving issue at the time of their death, then such issue shall take by per stirpes and representation the part that his or her parent would have received had he survived me.

ARTICLE SIX

I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my son, Henry Dale Schrader, as sole Executor of this my LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT, and I exempt him from giving any bond or security to qualify to act as such Executor and I do further exempt him from making any inventory or report of final settlement of the administration of my estate to any court whatsoever. I fully authorize and empower my said Executor to do all things necessary for the complete administration of my estate, to compromise, adjust and otherwise settle all claims, debts, charges or demands
