KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

WHEREAS, a Certificate of Competency has been granted by the Obligee to the above bounden Principal authorizing him to perform the indicated specified activity below in the State of Alabama:

NOW THEREAFTER, the condition of the Obligation is such that if the said Principal Shall faithfully observe the provisions of the Laws, Rules and Regulations, Conditions, Criteria and Orders governing onsite sewage disposal systems, then this Obligation shall be null and void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

Liability under this bond shall terminate as of the 29th day of March, 2003 as to any acts subsequent thereto, unless said bond is continued in force from year to year by the issuance of a continuation certificate signed by the Surety. Bond will automatically expire upon termination of employment with above employer. However in no event shall the Surety be liable for more than the penal sum of the bond.

The Surety may cancel this bond at any time by filing with the Obligee forty-five (45) day written notice of its desire to be relieved of liability. The Surety shall not be discharged from any liability already accrued under this bond, or which shall accrue hereunder before the expiration of the forty-five (45) day period.

RESOLVED FURTHER that the signature of any authorized officer and the seal of the company may be affixed by facsimile to any Power of Attorney or certification thereof authorizing the execution and delivery of any bond, undertaking, recognizance, or other suretyship obligations of the company, and such signature and seal when so used shall have the same force and effect as though manually affixed.
