I, Martha Jayne Yeilding, a resident of the County of Jefferson, State of Alabama, hereby make this my Last Will and Testament, and do hereby revoke all former wills and codicils thereto which may have been at any time heretofore made by me.

ITEM ONE

I will and direct that my just debts and funeral expenses and expenses of my last illness and all valid charges upon my estate be paid by my Co-Executors hereinafter named, as soon after my death as they may deem practicable.

ITEM TWO

I give, devise and bequeath all of my estate, including all property and all interest in property, real, personal or mixed, of every kind or character, wheresoever situated, of which I may die seized or possessed or to which I may be entitled at the time of my death, unto my beloved children, Martha Yeilding Scribner and Leslie Lannan Yeilding, in equal shares, share and share alike, absolutely and forever, per stirpes.

ITEM THREE

I constitute and appoint my beloved children, Martha Yeilding Scribner and Leslie Lannan Yeilding, as Co-Executors hereunder. It is my intention that all acts performed by them as Co-Executors shall be joint and not as one acting alone, and any sole act by either of the Co-Executors shall not be valid. I direct that my Co-Executors shall not be

required to give bond nor to file an inventory or appraisal of my estate in any court. I direct that they shall be free from the control and supervision of any court. I hereby vest in my Co-Executors the power to collect the income from the assets of my estate; to compromise, adjust and settle in their discretion any claim in favor of or against my estate; to hold any property received by them so long as they shall consider the retention for the best interests of my estate; to sell, auction, convey, exchange, lease or rent for any period of time any property in my estate, or to grant options for or in connection with such purposes, or otherwise dispose of all or any portion of my estate, in such manner and upon such terms and conditions as they may approve, and to do any and all other things with respect to the management of my estate as if they were the absolute owners thereof.

In the event that either my daughter or my son do not survive me, or are unable or unwilling to serve as Co-Executor for any reason, the other party shall continue to serve as the sole Executor with the same powers, immunities and privileges hereinabove given to my Co-Executors.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, Martha Jayne Yeilding, the Testatrix, do sign my name to this instrument this the 20th day of July, 1994, and being first duly sworn, do hereby declare to the undersigned authority that I sign and execute this instrument as my Last Will and Testament and that I sign it willingly, that I execute it as my free and voluntary act for the purposes therein expressed, and that I am nineteen (19) years of age or older, of sound mind, and under no constraint or undue influence.
