The name of the property owner concerned together with the property sought to be condemned is as set forth below:



A parcel of land situated in the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 14, Township 24 North, Range 15 East, Shelby County, Alabama, being more particularly described as follows:

Commence at a 1 and 1/2-inch open-top iron found, locally accepted to be the Northeast corner of said quarter-quarter section; thence run West along the North line of said quarter-quarter section for a distance of 134.28 feet to the point of beginning; thence turn an angle to the left of 96 degrees, 14 minutes, 05 seconds and run in a Southeasterly direction for a distance of 55.53 feet to a point on a curve to the left, having a central angle of 36 degrees, 07 minutes, 29 seconds and a radius of 294.23 feet; thence run in a Southeasterly direction along the arc of said curve for a distance of 185.51 feet to a point on a reverse curve to the right, having a central angle of 14 degrees, 07 minutes, 30 seconds and a radius of 380.00 feet; thence run in a Southeasterly direction along the arc of said curve for a distance of 93.68 feet to a point on the East line of said quarter-quarter section; thence turn an angle from the chord of last stated curve to the right of 35 degrees, 08 minutes, 25 seconds and run in a Southerly direction along said East line for a distance of 279.30 feet to a point on a curve to the right, having a central angle of 15 degrees, 29 minutes, 58 seconds and a radius of 350.00 feet; thence turn an angle to the chord of said curve to the right of 24 degrees, 25 minutes, 36 seconds and run in a Southwesterly direction along the arc of said curve for a distance of 94.68 feet to a point; thence run tangent to last stated curve in a Southwesterly direction for a distance of 385.24 feet to a point on a curve to the left, having a central angle of 23 degrees, 55 minutes, 20 seconds and a radius of 532.62 feet; thence run in a Southwesterly direction along the arc of said curve for a distance of 222.38 feet to a point; thence run tangent to last stated curve in a Southwesterly direction for a distance of 125.78 feet to a point on the South line of said quarter-quarter section; thence turn an angle to the right of 82 degrees, 25 minutes, 01 seconds and run in a Westerly direction along said South line for a distance of 40.35 feet to a point; thence turn an angle to the right of 97 degrees, 34 minutes, 59 seconds and run in a Northeasterly direction for a distance of 131.11 feet to a point on a curve to the right, having a central angle of 23 degrees, 55 minutes, 20 seconds and a radius of 572.62 feet; thence run in a Northeasterly direction along the arc of said curve for a distance of 239.08 feet to a point; thence run tangent to last stated curve in a Northeasterly direction for a distance of 385.24 feet to a point on a curve to the left, having a central angle of 74 degrees, 22 minutes, 44 seconds and a radius of 310.00 feet; thence run in a Northeasterly to Northwesterly direction along the arc of said curve for a distance of 402.43 feet to a point on a reverse curve to the right, having a central angle of 36 degrees, 07 minutes, 29 seconds and a radius of 364.23 feet; thence run in a Northwesterly direction along the arc of said curve for a distance of 229.64 feet to a point; thence run tangent to last stated curve in a Northwesterly direction for a distance of 63.18 feet to a point on the North line of said quarter-quarter section; thence turn an angle to the right of 96 degrees, 14 minutes, 05 seconds and run in an Easterly direction along said North line for a distance of 70.42 feet to the point of beginning; said parcel containing 1.544 acres, more or less.
