## FINAL JUDGMENT OF DIVORCE

THIS CAUSE, coming on to be heard, was submitted for final judgment upon the pleadings and proof ore tenus. Upon consideration thereof, it is, therefore,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT as follows:

FIRST: That the bonds of matrimony previously existing between the plaintiff and defendant are dissolved, and that they are forever divorced from each other for and on account of incompatibility of temperament.

SIXTH: The plaintiff, Treasa Keith, shall have full title to the following described real estate presently titled in the name of Kevin B. Keith, by deed from Lanier L. Price and wife, Juanita P. Price, to Kevin B. Keith, dated April 27, 1998, and recorded in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, which real estate is more particularly described as follows:

Lot 2, according to Hill Top Estates, as recorded in Map Book 16, Page 46, and re-recorded in Map Book 18, Page 22, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama; being situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

There is also conveyed to the Grantee, her heirs, successors and assigns, the right to use the present boat launching site, as granted to Grantor in deed as recorded in Deed Book 276, Page 881, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, for the purpose of launching boats for their private use, together with the right to fish from the bank of Lay Lake on property now owned by the Grantor.
