LEGAL DESCRIPTION

PARCEL ONE:

Commence at the Southeast Corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 2, Township 22 South, Range 4 West; thence North 00 degrees 18 minutes 00 seconds West along the east line of said $\frac{1}{4}$ - $\frac{1}{4}$ section and run 210.02 feet to a $\frac{1}{2}$ " rebar; thence continue North 00 degrees 22 minutes 07 seconds West and run 137.31 feet to a $\frac{1}{2}$ " rebar; thence North 27 degrees 31 minutes 17 seconds West and run 118.55 feet to a $\frac{1}{2}$ " rebar on the Southerly right-of-way line of County Road No. 10; thence South 31 degrees 15 minutes 33 seconds West and run 180.02 feet to a $\frac{1}{2}$ " rebar; thence North 22 degrees 57 minutes 57 seconds West and run 130.00 feet to a $\frac{3}{8}$ " rebar; thence North 14 degrees 35 minutes 04 seconds East and run 116.29 feet to a point; thence North 49 degrees 14 minutes 32 seconds East and run 42.34 feet to a $\frac{5}{8}$ " rebar on the Southerly right-of-way line of County Road No. 10, said point being on a curve to the right having a central angle of 10 degrees 52 minutes 38 seconds and a radius of 709.50 feet; thence along the chord of said curve South 37 degrees 59 minutes 32 seconds East and run a chord distance of 134.49 feet back to the Point of Beginning.

PARCEL TWO:

Commence at an old 3" pipe locally known as the Southeast corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 2, Township 22 South, Range 4 West; thence North 00 degrees 18 minutes 00 seconds West along the east line of said $\frac{1}{4}$ - $\frac{1}{4}$ section and run 210.02 feet to a $\frac{1}{2}$ " rebar; thence continue North 00 degrees 22 minutes 07 seconds West and run 137.31 feet to a $\frac{1}{2}$ " rebar; thence North 27 degrees 31 minutes 17 seconds West and run 118.55 feet to a $\frac{1}{2}$ " rebar; thence South 31 degrees 15 minutes 33 seconds West and run 180.02 feet to a $\frac{1}{2}$ " rebar and also the Point of Beginning; thence North 22 degrees 57 minutes 57 seconds West and run 130.00 feet to a $\frac{3}{8}$ " rebar; thence North 14 degrees 35 minutes 04 seconds East and run 116.29 feet to a point; thence South 48 degrees 55 minutes 10 seconds West and run 122.70 feet to a $\frac{5}{8}$ " rebar; thence South 50 degrees 54 minutes 59 seconds West and run 19.99 feet to a $\frac{5}{8}$ " rebar; thence South 42 degrees 57 minutes 35 seconds East and run 190.05 feet back to the Point of Beginning.
