

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

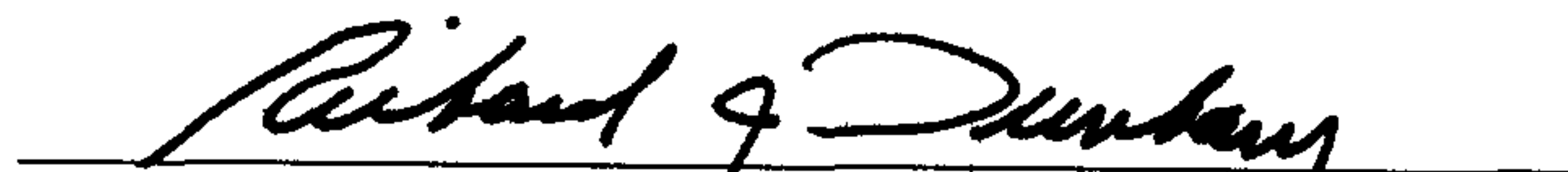
