SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT


WHEREAS, there is currently pending in the above-mentioned case a dispute between Jackie Anderson, the Plaintiff, and David Byers, the Defendant, regarding the claims raised in the Complaint filed by Jackie Anderson in Civil Action No. CV-00-BU-1093-S;

WHEREAS, the parties have negotiated a satisfactory settlement among themselves; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to file of record the Settlement Agreement containing the agreement between the parties, the parties state as follows:

- 1. That Defendant, David Byers shall pay to Jackie Anderson the sum of Three Thousand Dollars and No/100 (\$3,000.00) by cash or certified funds no later than thirty (30) days from the execution of the Settlement Agreement. Payment may be directed through Jackie Anderson's attorneys of record, Gorham & Waldrep, P.C.
- 2. That further David Byers consents to a judgment being entered against David Byers, Sr., and in favor of Jackie Anderson in the amount of Twenty Thousand Dollars and No/100 (\$20,000.00), said judgment to be entered upon the court record by separate order of judgment.
- 3. That at exchange for the promises made in paragraph No. 1 and 2 above, Jackie Anderson agrees to dismiss the pending case in CV-00-BU-1093-S with prejudice upon receipt of the Three Thousand Dollars and No/100 (\$3,000.00) as stated in Paragraph 1 and the entry of the Twenty Thousand Dollar and No/100 (\$20,000.00) judgment as stated in Paragraph 2.
- 4. That both parties shall bear their own costs and attorneys' fees and any costs of Court shall be charged as paid.

- 5. That the parties request this Honorable Court by a motion separately file to retain jurisdiction of this matter for a period of sixty (60) days from the execution of the Settlement Agreement to facilitate the payment of the money mentioned in Paragraph 1 above, the entry of the judgment pursuant to Paragraph 2 and the Dismissal with Prejudice pursuant to Paragraph 3 above.
- 6. That both parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of the terms of this settlement agreement. The parties may only disclose the terms of this settlement agreement to their attorneys, to obtain tax advice, or as ordered by a court of competent jurisdiction. The parties further agree that a
