

**Durable General Power of Attorney
to
Albert Moore McNeel**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Mary Jackson McNeel, of 2300 5th Avenue North, Apt 109, Birmingham, Alabama 35203, being over the age of twenty-one (21) years, do hereby appoint Albert Moore McNeel of 2204 Napoleon Court, Birmingham, Alabama 35243, as my true and lawful attorney and authorize and empower said attorney for me and in my name to:

(1) Ask, demand, sue for, collect, recover, and receive all sums of money, debts, accounts, interest, dividends, annuities, and demands whatsoever as are now or shall hereafter become due, owing, payable or belonging to me.

(2) Make, do and transact all and every kind of business of whatever nature it is considered necessary by Albert Moore McNeel, including the power to draw checks on my bank account or accounts and make deposits therein and perform any and all other banking functions.

(3) Make, seal, and deliver; to bargain, contract, agree for, buy, sell, mortgage, hypothecate, and in any and every way and manner deal in and with goods and personal property, in possession or in action, and to release mortgages on lands or chattels.

(4) Bargain, contract, agree for, purchase, receive and take lands, tenements, hereditaments and accept the seizen and possession of all lands and deeds, lease, bargain, sell, release and satisfy mortgages, release, convey, mortgage and hypothecate lands, tenements and hereditaments, upon such terms and conditions, and under such covenants, as shall be deemed advisable.

(5) Sign, seal, execute, acknowledge and deliver such deeds, leases and assignment of leases, agreements, mortgages, releases and satisfaction of mortgages and other such instruments in writing of whatever kind and nature as may be necessary or proper in the premises.

(6) Giving and granting unto Albert Moore McNeel, as my true and lawful attorney, full power and authority to do and perform every act and thing whatsoever requisite and necessary to be done in and about the premises, including but not limited to the specific powers granted herein, as fully to all intent and purposes as I might or could do if personally present.

(7) I hereby ratify and confirm all that Albert Moore McNeel, as my true and lawful attorney, shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of these presents.

(8) This power of attorney shall not be affected by disability, incompetency or incapacity of the principal.
