**WARRANTY DEED, JOINTLY FOR LIFE**  
**WITH REMAINDER TO SURVIVOR**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That in consideration of other good and valuable considerations and the sum of **One Hundred Seventy Five Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$175,000.00)** to the undersigned GRANTORS in hand paid by the GRANTEES herein, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, **Benjamin A. Crunk and April K. Crunk, husband and wife** (hereinafter referred to as GRANTORS), do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto **Susan B. Neuhoff, a married woman, joined by her spouse, Lorenz Neuhoff** (hereinafter referred to as GRANTEES), for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described real estate situated in the County of **Shelby** and State of Alabama, to-wit:


**This conveyance is hereby made subject to restrictions, easements and rights of way of record in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.**

Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining in fee simple.


