WARRANTY DEED

STATE OF ALABAMA

SHELBY COUNTY KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,


That in consideration of One and no/100 DOLLARS (\$1.00) to the undersigned GRANTOR in hand paid by the GRANTEE herein, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, and in order to divide jointly owned real property between the GRANTOR and the GRANTEE, the undersigned Graham N. Webster and Ruby Webster, husband and wife (herein referred to as GRANTOR, whether one or more) do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Graham N. Webster (herein referred to as GRANTEE, whether one or more) the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Alabama to-wit:


A part of Lots 5,6,7 and 8, according to the Decree and map in Case # 2994 in the Circuit Court of Shelby County, Alabama, in equity, style of case being Howard et al. v. Harrison, et al., which said decree and map are recorded in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, in Deed Book 138, Pages 555 and 556, all being in Section 1, Township 21, Range 5 West, more particularly described as follows: Begin at the SE corner of said Lot 5, according to the decree and map in Case # 2294, and run in a Westerly direction along the South boundary line of said Lot s 5,6,7 and 8 a distance of 1320 feet; thence turn right an angle of 89° 14' 15" in a northerly direction a distance of 990 feet; thence turn right an angle of 90° 44' 45" in an easterly direction a distance of 1320 feet; thence turn right an angle of 89° 14' 15" in a southerly direction a distance of 990 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning. Containing 30 acres, more or less, according to survey and plat of James W. Elliott, PE&LS reg. no. 3009.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD to the said GRANTEE, his, her or their heirs and assigns forever.

And GRANTOR does for GRANTOR and for GRANTOR'S heirs, executors, and administrators covenant with the said GRANTEE and GRANTEE'S heirs and assigns, that GRANTOR is lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises; that they are free from all encumbrances unless otherwise noted above; that GRANTOR has a good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid; that GRANTOR will and GRANTOR'S heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said GRANTEE and GRANTEE'S heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims of all persons.


