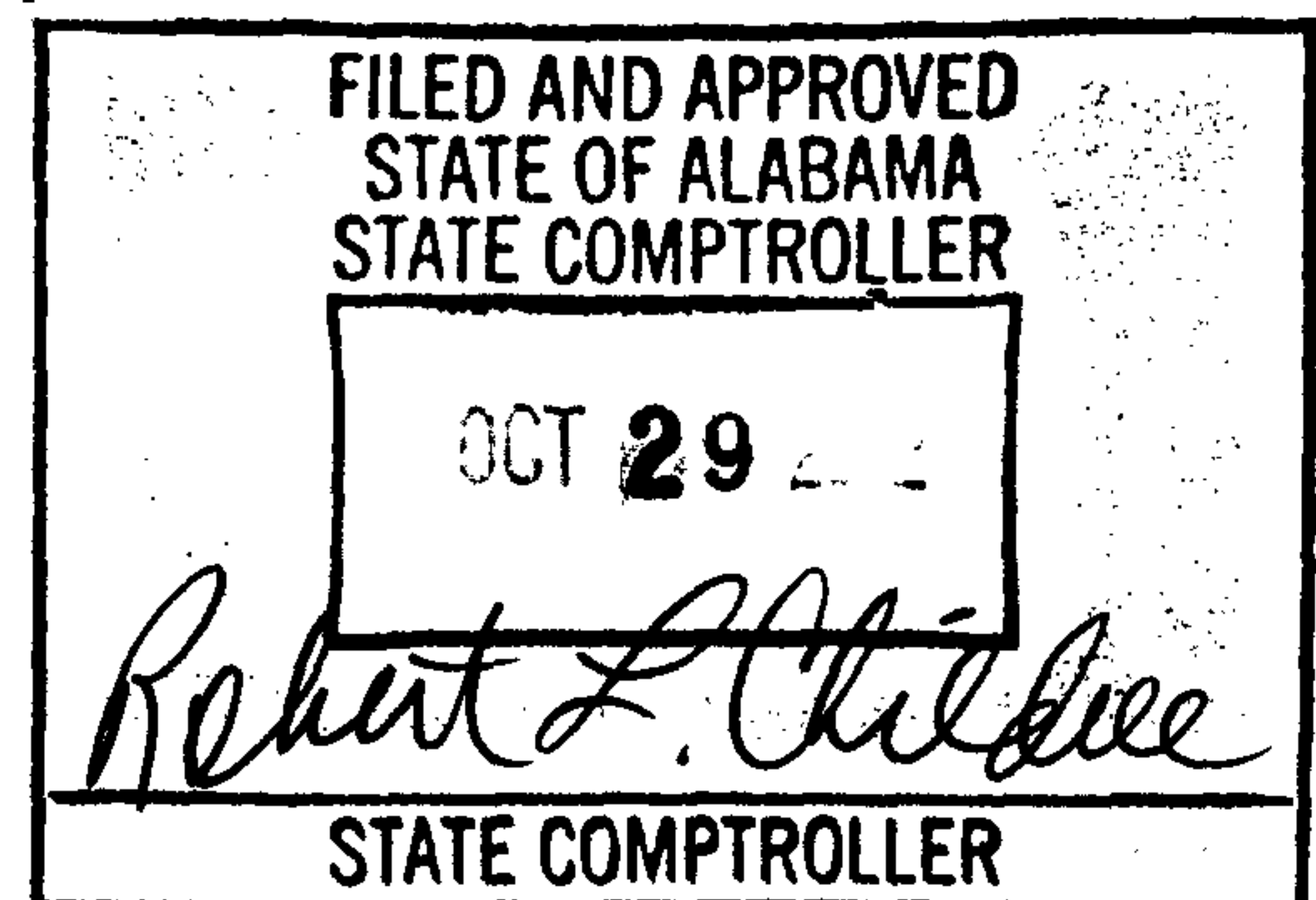

The authority hereby granted shall expire August 1, 2004 unless sooner revoked.

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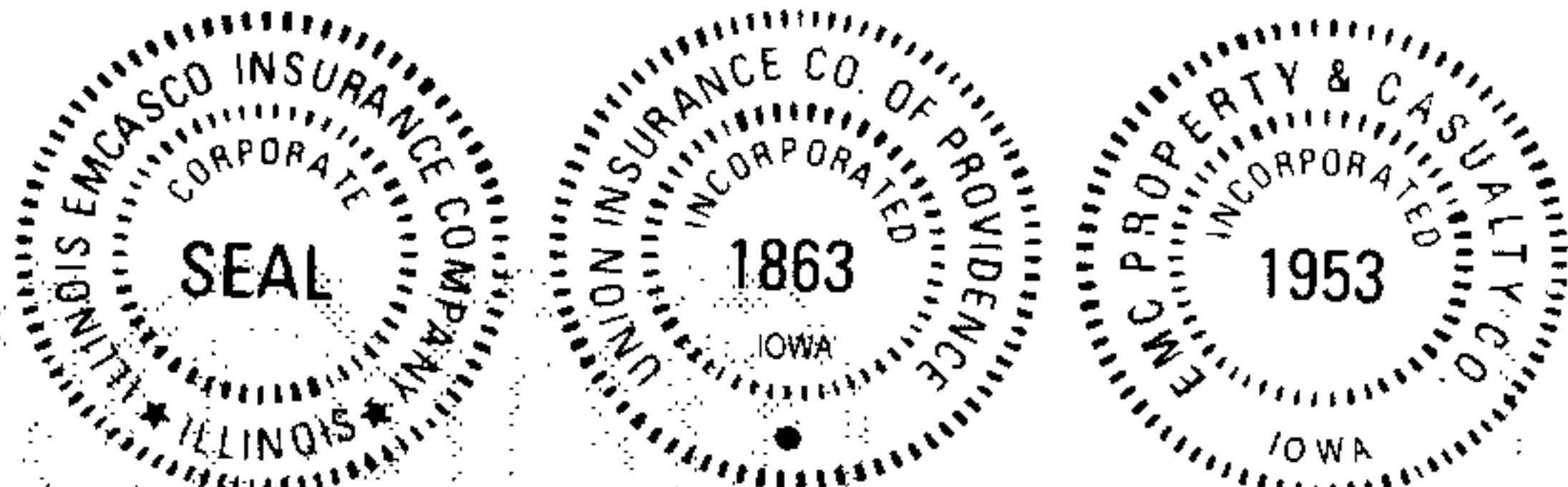
AUTHORITY FOR POWER OF ATTORNEY

The facsimile or mechanically reproduced signature of such officer, whether made heretofore or hereafter, wherever appearing upon a certified copy of any power-of-attorney of the Company, shall be valid and binding upon the Company with the same force and affect as though manually affixed.
