Subject to easements, set back lines, restrictions, covenants, mineral and mining rights and current taxes due.

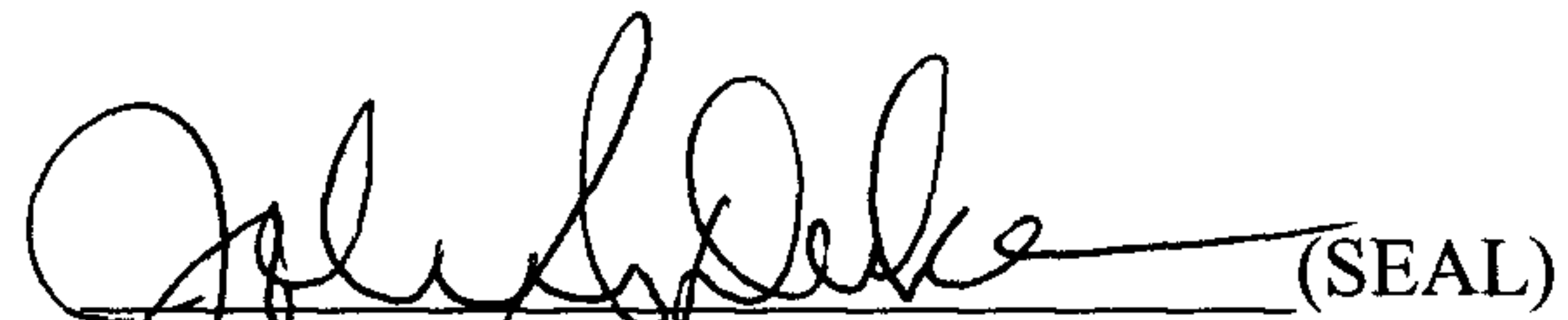
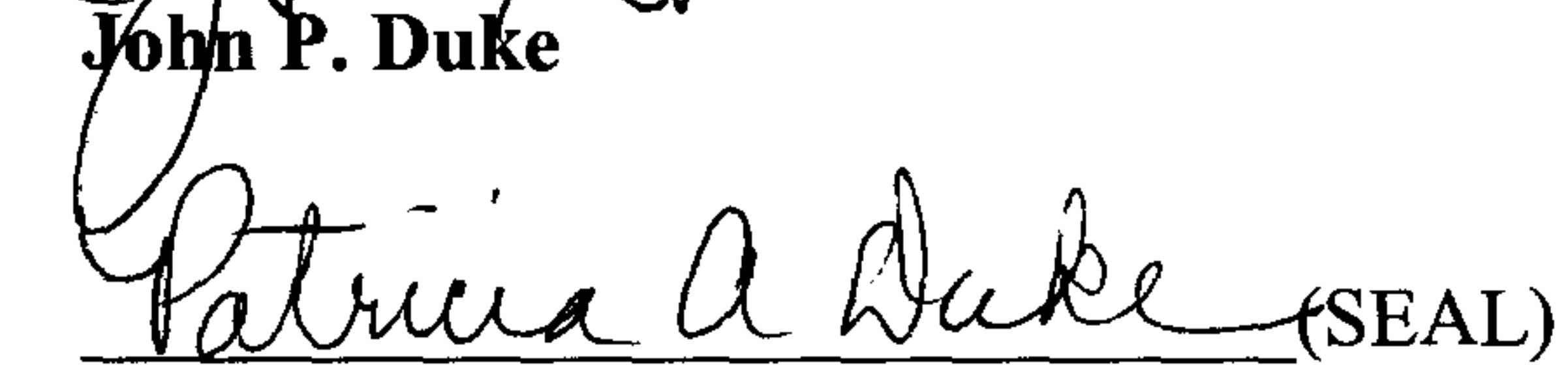
\$493,000.00 of the above consideration above paid from the proceeds of purchase money closed herewith.

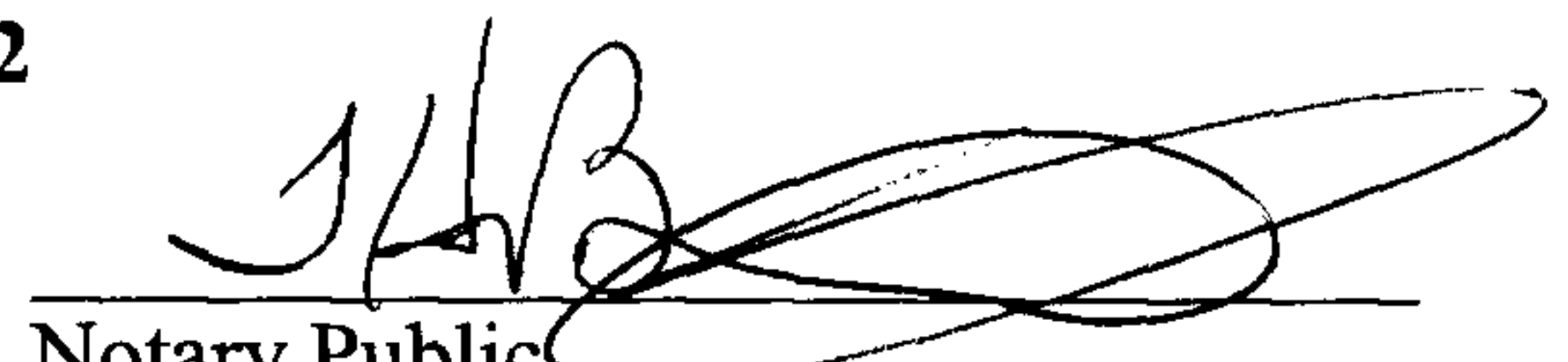
