

## ORDINANCE NO. 02-1922

An ordinance to alter, rearrange and extend the corporate limits of the City of Hoover, Alabama, so as to embrace and include within the corporate limits of said City all territory now within such corporate limits and also certain other territory contiguous to said City.

WHEREAS, a petition signed by <u>Daniel Oak Mountain Limited Partnership</u> requesting that certain territory described therein be annexed to the City of Hoover, and

WHEREAS, there is attached to the said petition a map of said territory showing its relationship to the corporate limits of the City; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined and found that the matters set forth and alleged in the said petition are true and that it is in the public interest that said property be annexed into the City of Hoover;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Hoover as follows:

SECTION 1: That said Council hereby assents to the annexation of said territory to the City of Hoover, Alabama, and the corporate limits of the City of Hoover are hereby extended and rearranged pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 42, Article 2, Code of Alabama, 1975 (Sections 11-42-20 through 11-42-23, as amended) so as to embrace and include said territory, in addition to the territory already within its present corporate limits, within the corporate area of said City, which said territory is not within the corporate limits or municipal boundaries of another municipality and does not lie at any point more than one-half the distance between the present corporate limits and the corporate limits of any other municipality. Said property is described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2: The City Clerk shall file a certified copy of this ordinance containing an accurate description of said annexed territory with the Probate Judge of Shelby County, Alabama, and also cause a copy of this ordinance to be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Hoover.

#### EXHIBIT "A"

## Phase IV 27 Acres Adjacent to Greystone

The Southeast one-half of the Northwest one-half of the Northwest one-half of the Northwest one-half of the following parcel of land situated in Sections 28 and 29, Township 18 South, Range 1 West, Shelby County, Alabama, being more particularly described as follows:

Begin at a 2-inch open-top pipe locally accepted to be the Southwest corner of the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of said Section 28; thence run along an assumed bearing of North 44 degrees, 37 minutes, 00 seconds East for a distance of 1,127.35 feet to a 3/8-inch rebar found; thence turn an angle to the right of 65 degrees, 13 minutes, 53 seconds and run in a Southeasterly direction for a distance of 514.17 feet to a 1 ½-inch solid bar found on the East line of said quarter-quarter section; thence turn an angle to the right of 70 degrees, 18 minutes, 50 seconds and run in a Southerly direction along said East line for a distance of 629.16 feet to an iron pin found; thence turn an angle to the right of 42 degrees, 51 minutes, 11 seconds and run in a southwesterly direction for a distance of 813.27 feet to an iron pin found; thence turn an angle to the right of 71 degrees, 30 minutes, 43 seconds and run in a Northwesterly direction for a distance of 107.60 feet to a 3/8-inch rebar found; thence turn and angle to the left of 01 degree, 31 minutes, 10 seconds and run in a Northwesterly direction for a distance of 835.46 feet to an iron pin set; thence turn an angle to the right of 69 degrees, 01 minutes, 15 seconds and run in a Northerly direction for a distance of 229.78 feet to a point on the South line of the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of said Section 29; thence turn an angle to the right of 90 degrees, 00 minutes, 00 seconds and run in an Easterly direction along said South line for a distance of 140.00 feet to the point of beginning; said parcel containing 27.149 acres, more or less.
