

**ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION
OF
SED, LLC**

The undersigned, intending to organize a limited liability company under the provisions of the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act, as amended, ALA. CODE §§ 10-12-2, *et seq.* (the "Act"), hereby adopts the following Articles of Organization (the "Articles"). Capitalized terms used but not defined herein have the meanings set forth in the Act.

**ARTICLE I
NAME**

The name of the limited liability company, referred to in these Articles as the "Company," is "SED, LLC."

**ARTICLE II
DURATION**

The period of duration of the Company shall be perpetual.

**ARTICLE III
PURPOSE**

The purposes for which the Company is organized are to conduct such lawful business for which limited liability companies may be organized under the Act as may be specifically authorized by consent of the Members in accordance with the provisions of the Operating Agreement.

**ARTICLE IV
REGISTERED AGENT AND OFFICE**

The name of the Company's initial registered agent in Alabama is James Weaver. The location and mailing address of the Company's registered office in Alabama and the address of said agent are 842 Snow Drive, Alabaster, AL 35007

ARTICLE V
INITIAL MEMBERS; ORGANIZER

ARTICLE VI
ADDITIONAL MEMBERS

The Member shall not have the right to admit additional Members, except upon the terms and conditions specified in the Operating Agreement, and only by unanimous written consent of the then existing Members.

ARTICLE VII
CESSATION OF MEMBERSHIP

The cessation of membership of one or more Members in the Company shall not result in a dissolution of the Company. The Company shall be dissolved and its affairs wound up upon the occurrence of any event set forth in the Operating Agreement or the Act.

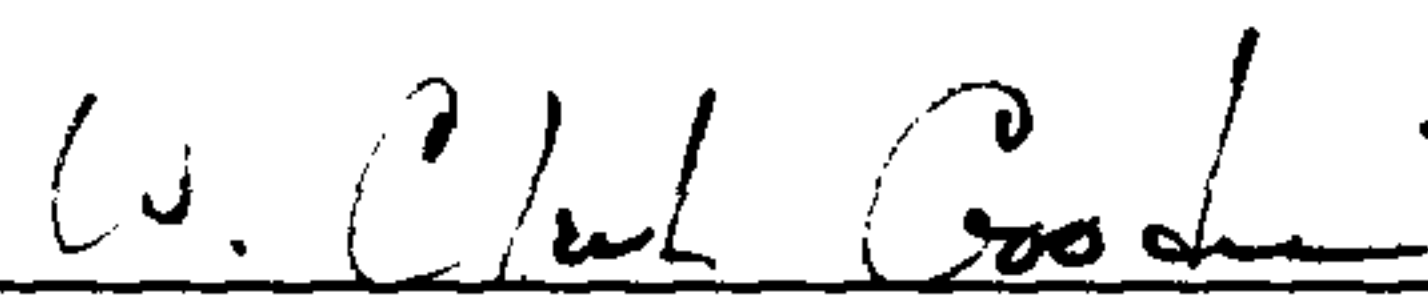
ARTICLE VIII
MISCELLANEOUS MATTERS

The Company shall have all of the powers of a limited liability company that are set out in the Act. The Member has executed an Operating Agreement which shall govern the affairs of the Company and the conduct of its business.

The Company shall be treated as a partnership for purposes of federal and state income tax purposes.
