

**FIRST ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT
TO THE
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 10-2B-01 et seq. of the Alabama Business Corporation Act, the undersigned corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation:

First: The name of the corporation is **AARGOOD MOVING, INC.**

Second: The following amendment of the articles of incorporation were adopted by the shareholders and directors of the corporation on May 9, 2003 in the manner prescribed by the Alabama Business Corporation Act:

The name of the corporation is hereby changed from
AARGOOD Moving, Inc., to **AARGOOD
RELOCATION, INC.**

Third: The number of shares of the corporation outstanding at the time of such adoption, and the number of shares entitled to vote thereon was 1000 shares of common stock.

Fourth: The number of shares voted for such amendment was 1000; and no shares were voted against such amendment.

Fifth: Except as hereinabove set forth, the Articles of Incorporation of the corporation are hereby ratified, confirmed and approved.





OF AARGOOD MOVING, INC.**






