

AN EASEMENT  
FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION, AND MAINTENANCE  
OF A UTILITY

BY THE CITY OF CALERA, ALABAMA

This EASEMENT, executed this 18th day of May, 2000, for the construction, operation, and maintenance of a utility with appurtenances, by The City of Calera, hereinafter called the OWNER across the property of the LANDOWNER, Mayanice and T. H. Walton whose deed is recorded in Deed Book 151, Page 372 of the public records of Shelby County, Alabama as shown on the attached sketch, is granted by the LANDOWNER to the OWNER for valuable considerations, the receipt and sufficiency of which are acknowledged by the LANDOWNER, for himself, and his heirs, executors, successors, and assigns.

One permanent easement, to go with the land to allow the OWNER, its employees and agents to construct, operate, repair, and maintain the OWNER'S utility, including the right of access by the OWNER, its employees and agents, or officials, and necessary related equipment. Included is the right to uncover the utility, with the obligation to leave the LANDOWNER'S property in good repair after completion of any repair to the utility.

The easement is described as follows:

Commence at the southeast corner of Section 33, Township 21 South, Range 2 West in Shelby County, Alabama; thence run west along the south line of said section to the east right-of-way of Highway 31 and the Point of Beginning; thence run south along said right-of-way 130'; thence run east 10'; thence run north and parallel to said right-of-way 130' to the Walton north property line; thence run west 10' back to the Point of Beginning.
