

Durable Power of Attorney (General)

I, <u>Willie Williams, Jr.</u>, the undersigned Principal, hereby grant this General Power of Attorney to <u>Rosie M. Williams-Jones</u>, as my attorney-in-fact.

My attorney-in-fact shall have full power and authority to do any and all acts on my behalf that I could do personally including but not limited to:

the right to sell, deed, buy, trade, lease, mortgage, assign, rent, or dispose of any of my present or future real or personal property;

the right to execute, accept, undertake, and perform any and all contracts in my name;

the right to deposit, endorse, or withdraw funds to or from any of my bank accounts, depositories or safe-deposit boxes;

My attorney-in-fact hereby accepts this appointment subject to its terms and agrees to act and perform in a fiduciary capacity consistent with my best interests as she in her best discretion deems advisable, and I affirm and ratify all acts so undertaken.

This power of attorney may be revoked by me at any time, and shall automatically be revoked upon my death, provided any person relying on this power of attorney before my death shall have full rights to accept the authority of my attorney-in-fact until in receipt of actual notice of revocation. It is my intention that this instrument be construed as a Durable Power of Attorney, and that it shall not be affected by my subsequent disability or incapacity.
