ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

South Shelby Heating, Cooling and Refrigeration, L.L.C.

The undersigned, acting as the organizers of a limited liability company under the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act, Code of Alabama, 1975, Title 10, Chapter 12, as the same may be amended from time to time, hereby adopt the following Articles of Organization for South Shelby Heating, Cooling, and Refrigeration, L.L.C. (the "limited liability company"):

ARTICLE ONE NAME

The name of the limited liability company is South Shelby Heating, Cooling, and Refrigeration, L.L.C.

ARTICLE TWO PERIOD OF DURATION

The limited liability company shall continue in existence until dissolved in accordance with the provisions of the limited liability company's Operating Agreement, or, if there is no provision in an Operating Agreement of the limited liability company governing dissolution of the limited liability company, then in accordance with the provisions of the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act.

ARTICLE THREE PURPOSE

The business of the limited liability company shall be, to the extent permitted by law, (1) to have and exercise all powers set forth in Code of Alabama, 1975, Section 10-12-4, as the same may be amended from time to time; and (2) to engage in any lawful business or other activity, whether or not related or incidental to any of the foregoing activities.

ARTICLE FOUR INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND REGISTERED AGENT

ARTICLE FIVE INITIAL MEMBERS

ARTICLE SIX ADDITIONAL MEMBERS

Additional members may be admitted in accordance with the terms of the limited liability company's Operating Agreement, if any. If the limited liability company does not have an Operating Agreement that provides for the admission of additional members, additional members may be admitted with the written consent of all members at such times and upon such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon by the members and the person desiring to become a member.

ARTICLE SEVEN CONTINUATION OF THE BUSINESS

The remaining members of the limited liability company shall continue the legal existence and business of the limited liability company after an event of dissociation terminates the continued membership of a member in the limited liability company if:

- (a) There are at least two remaining members, or there is at least one remaining member and a new member is admitted; and
- (b) The legal existence and business of the limited liability company is continued by the written consent of all of the remaining members within 90 days after the occurrence of the event of dissociation.

ARTICLE EIGHT MANAGEMENT

The management of the limited liability company is vested in the members. Subject to any provisions in an Operating Agreement of the limited liability company, or the provisions of Alabama Limited Liability Company Act restricting or enlarging the management rights and duties of any person or group or class of persons, the members shall have the right and authority to manage the business or affairs of the limited liability company and to make all decisions with respect thereto.

ARTICLE NINE AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION The Articles of Organization may be amended by the written consent of all members of the limited liability company.
