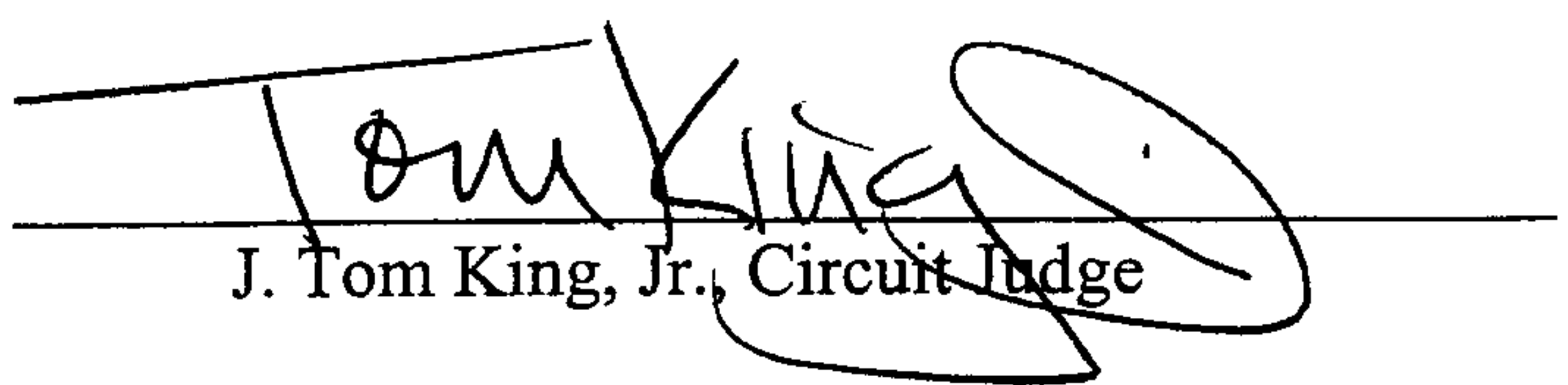

ORDER

Having considered the Motion for Entry of Default and for Judgment by Default filed on behalf of Plaintiff Banc of America Commercial Finance Corporation ("Banc of America"), as successor in interest to Nationscredit Commercial Corporation against defendant *Charles R. Smith* ("Smith"), it is hereby

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that judgment be entered against defendant Smith in the amount of \$260,309.22, comprised of \$249,605.92 in breach of lease damages, as set forth in the Complaint and in paragraph 10 of the Affidavit of Michael Collins filed on December 9, 2002; and \$10,703.30 in attorneys' fees and expenses, as set forth in the Lamar Affidavit at paragraph 10 and in the Collins Affidavit at paragraph 10, attached to the Motion. This judgment shall be made final pursuant to Alabama Rule of Civil Procedure 54(b), there being no just reason for delay.
