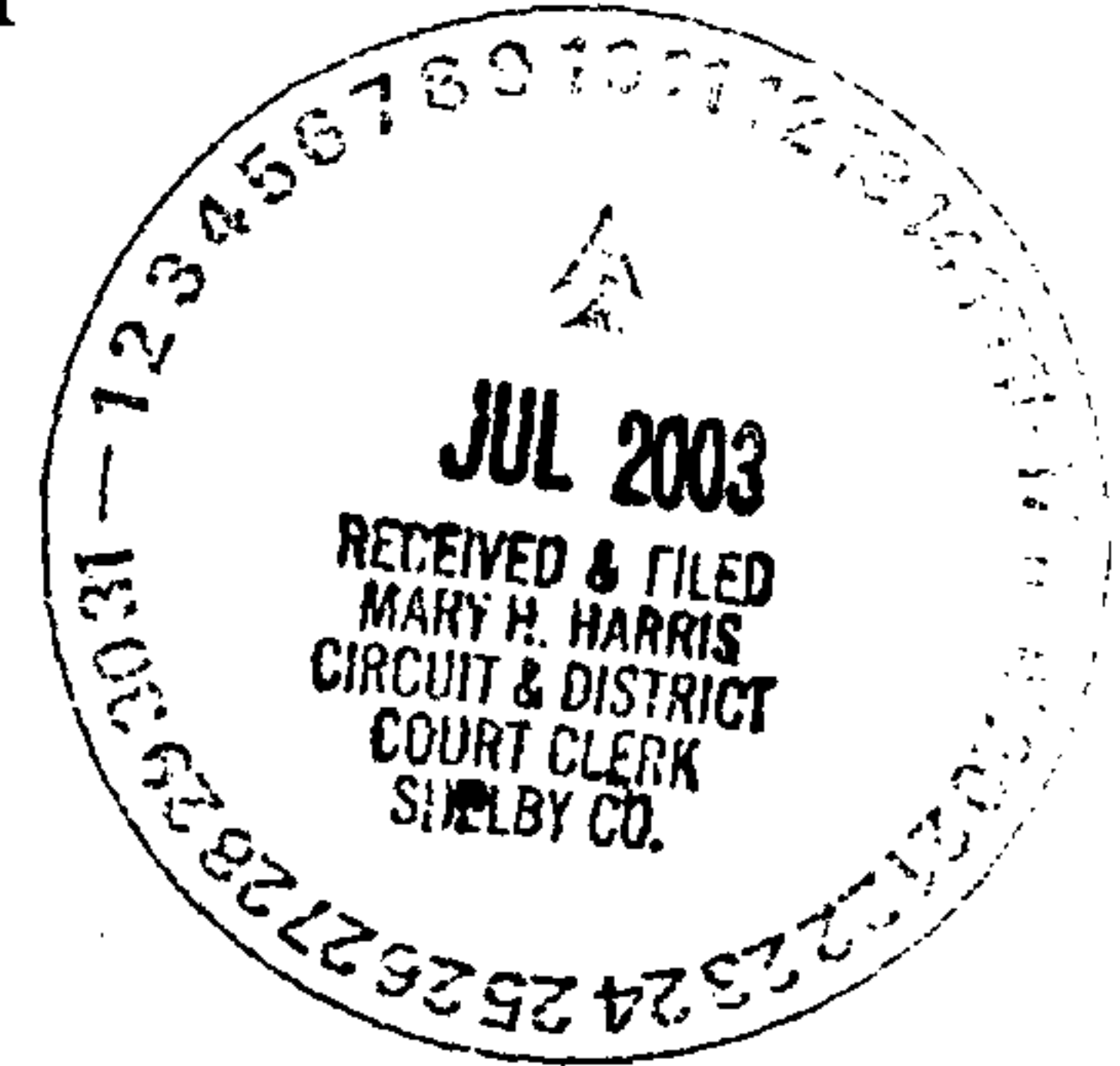

ORDER OF FINAL JUDGMENT

This matter comes before the Court on the Plaintiff's Complaint to expunge a mortgage satisfied of record by mistake. It appears to the satisfaction of the Court that the Defendant was served May 16, 2003, and has failed to appear, answer, or otherwise defend. Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED** and **ADJUDGED** that:

1. The mortgage executed to First Federal Savings Bank, now First Financial Bank, recorded August 3, 2000, in the Probate Court of Shelby County in Instrument number 2000-25998, was satisfied of record by mistake on two occasions:

- a) Instrument number 2001-24409 as recorded June 14, 2001 in the Probate Court of Shelby County, Alabama.
- b) Instrument number 2001-44253 as recorded October 11, 2001 in the Probate Court of Shelby County, Alabama.

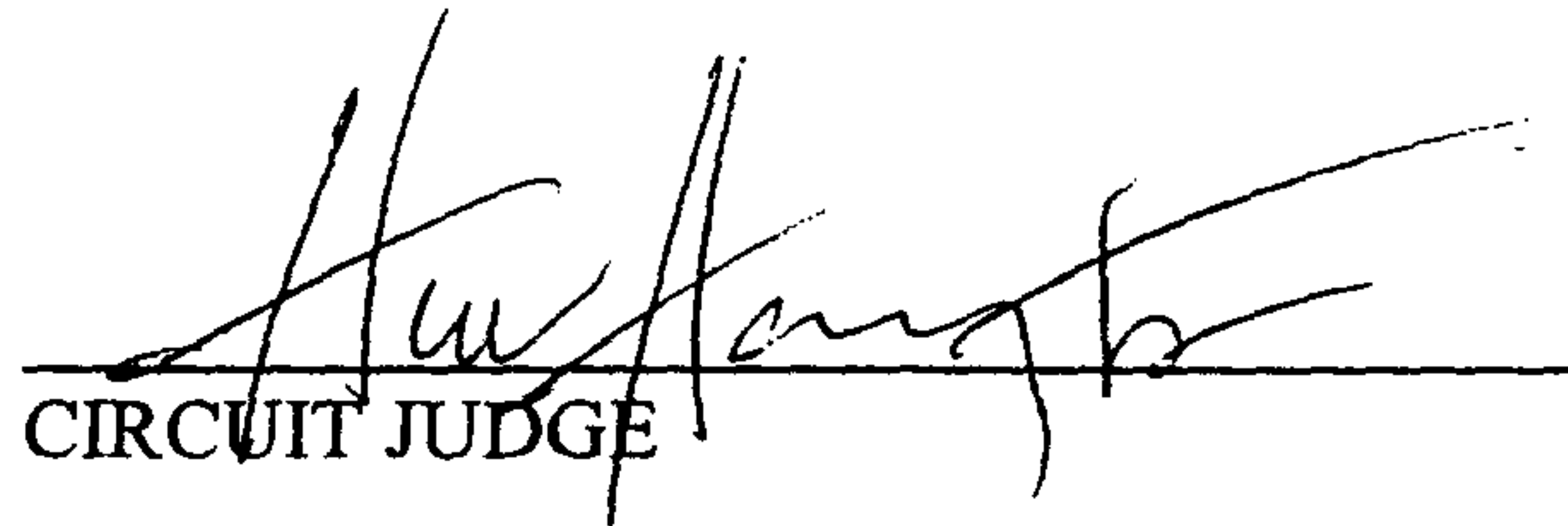

3. The Lis Pendens filed May 12, 2003, is hereby addressed and resolved by this Order.

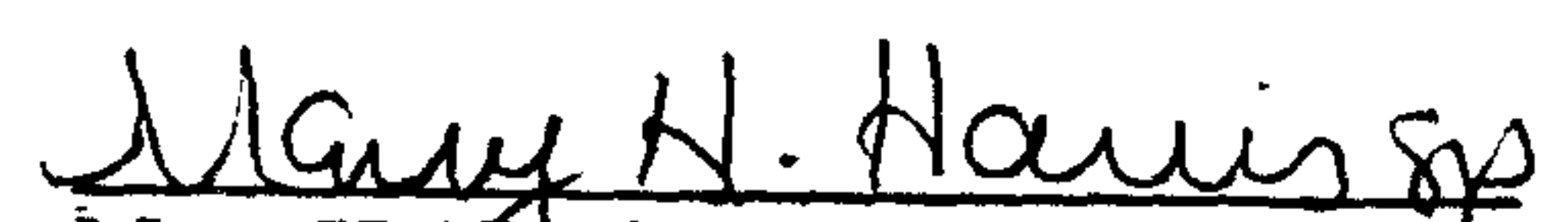
4. Plaintiff shall record a copy of this Order in the Probate Court of Shelby County, Alabama.
