- 1.) That my name is Claude M. Moncus, that I am over the age of 21 years, I have personal knowledge of the information contained herein. I am an attorney licensed to practice law in the State of Alabama.
- 2.) That on or about, May 28, 2003, I prepared a Joint Survivorship Deed (the "Deed") which is recorded in Instrument Number 20030619000384260 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, which Deed conveyed the property from Kenneth Dickson and wife Marsha T. Dickson, to Robert D. Weaver, an unmarried man (the "Purchaser"). The property conveyed is described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof...
- 3.) On May 28, 2003, the Purchase was an unmarried man. There is no joint owner named in the Deed, and it was not the Purchaser's intent to have a survivorship deed. This form should not have been a survivorship form. It should have been a regular Warranty Deed without survivorship language.
