

**Articles of Organization
Of

An Alabama Limited Liability Company**

Pursuant to the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act (the "Act"), the undersigned hereby adopts the following Limited Liability Company Articles of Organization:

**Article I
Name**

The name of the limited liability company (the "Company") is "J E J Enterprises, LLC".

**Article II
Duration**

The existence of the Company shall continue until terminated by agreement of the members or by operation of law.

**Article III
Purpose**

The Company's purposes are to engage in all aspects of business operations involving real estate sales, and to do everything necessary, proper, advisable or convenient for the accomplishment of such purpose and to do all other things incidental to such purpose or in connection with such purpose that are not prohibited by law. In extension and not in limitation of the purposes specifically enumerated, the Company is authorized and empowered to engage in any lawful business in which limited liability companies may engage under the Act.

Management

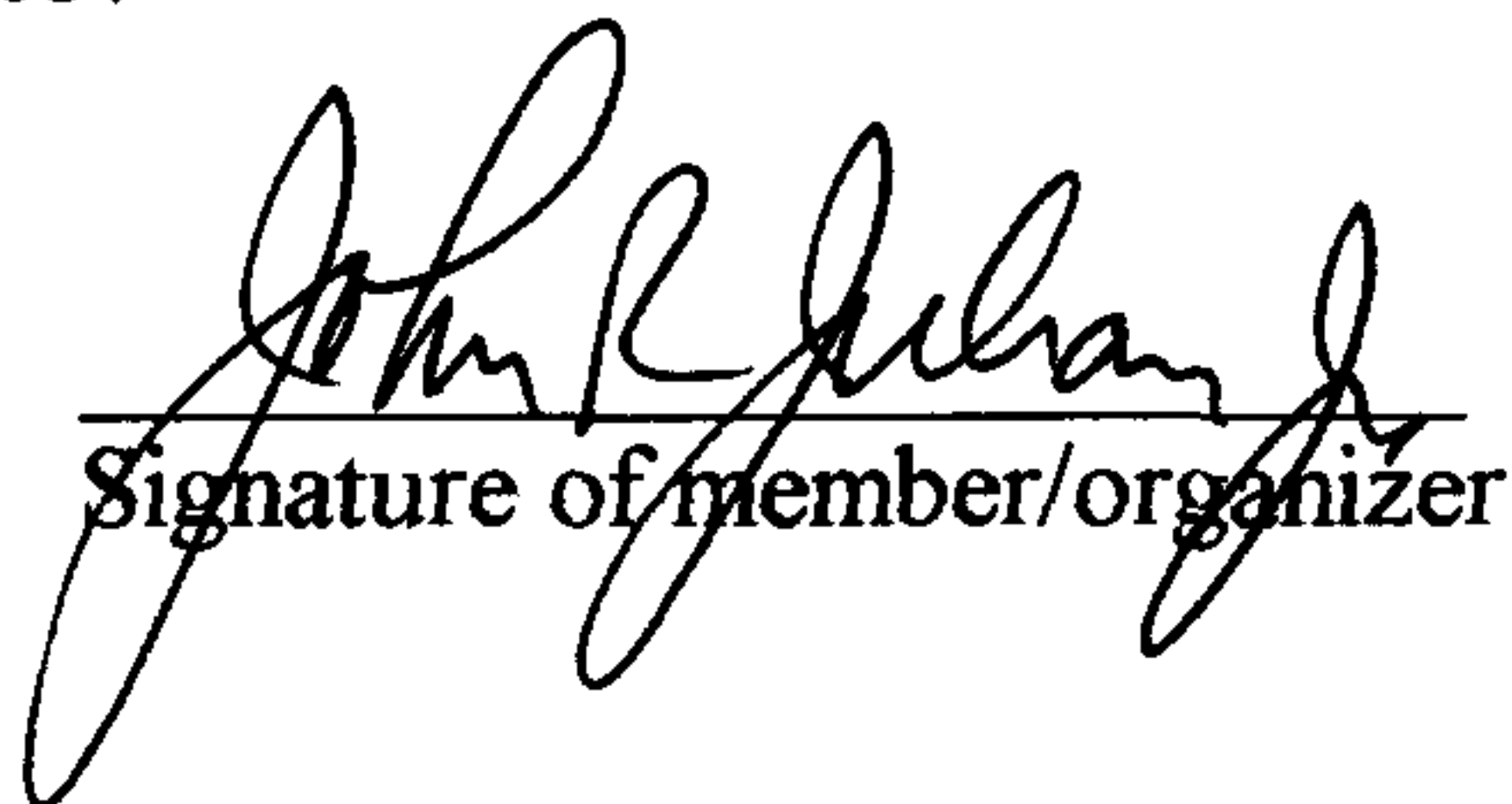
The Company shall be managed by the members, or, at any time when there is only one member, by that member.
