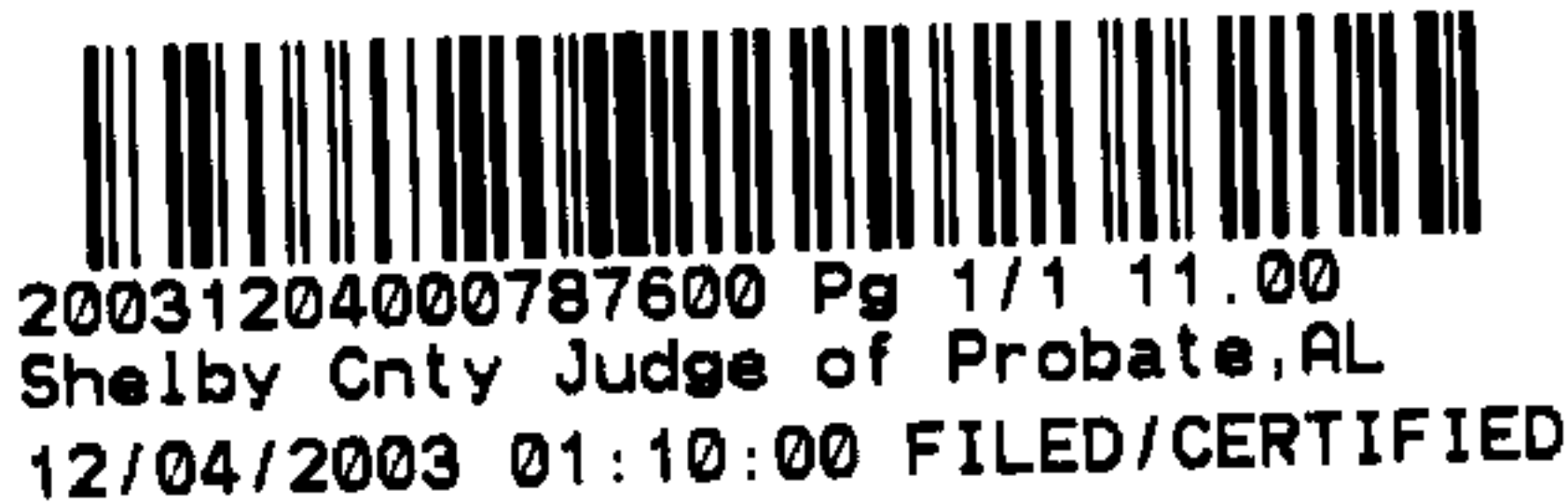

AFFIDAVIT OF HEIRSHIP



Before me, the undersigned authority, a Notary Public, in and for said State, personally appeared Burlin D. McManus, who after being by me first duly sworn, deposes, and says on oath as follows:

My name is Burlin D. McManus, and I am over the age of 21 years, and am familiar with the following facts:

I am one of the heirs at law of George W. Weldon. Since the sale of property owned by the heirs at law of George W. Weldon in 2001, four of the heirs at law have passed away, namely: Hoyt Isbell, Sandra Crawford, Dimmis Weldon Johnson, and Edgar Sidney Holland.
