CONSENT JUDGMENT

The above captioned adversary proceeding was commenced on or about JUNE 30, 2003, seeking to set aside a pre-petition foreclosure sale under Section 105(a), title 11, United States Code. Prior to any further proceedings in this Adversary Proceeding, the parties announced that a settlement had been reached and contemporaneously presented the judgment by consent prepared, agreed unto, and approved by the parties to the Adversary Proceeding. > Lot 9, Block 1, according to the Survey of Willow Glen, as recorded in Map Book 7, Page 101, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.
