CORPORATION WARRANTY DEED, JOINTLY
FOR LIFE WITH REMAINDER TO SURVIVOR

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That in consideration of other good and valuable considerations and the sum of **Two Hundred Ninety Nine Thousand Nine Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$299,900.00)** to the undersigned GRANTOR in hand paid by the GRANTEES herein, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, **Building Resources, Inc., an Alabama corporation** (hereinafter referred to as GRANTOR), does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto **Gregory L. Noelting and Sheri A. Noelting, husband and wife** (hereinafter referred to as GRANTEES), for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described real estate situated in the County of **Shelby** and State of **Alabama**, to-wit:

Lot 11, according to the Final Plat of Wild Timber, Phase I, as recorded in Map Book 31, at Page 59, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama; being situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

Note: \$110,000.00 of the above purchase price is in the form of a mortgage in favor of Wachovia Mortgage Corporation, executed and recorded simultaneously herewith.

This conveyance is hereby made subject to restrictions, easements and rights of way of record in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

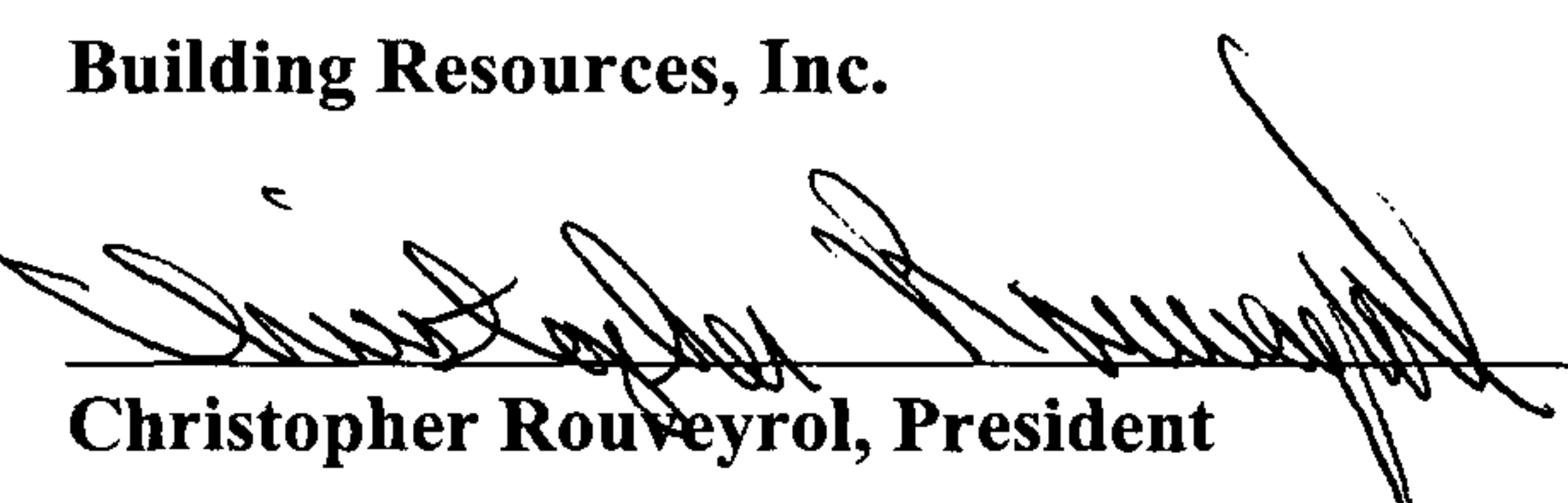
Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining in fee simple.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto GRANTEES for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, and to the heirs and assigns of such survivor forever, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion.

And said GRANTOR does for itself and its successors and assigns covenants with the said GRANTEES, their heirs and assigns, that it is lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises, that they are free from all encumbrances, unless otherwise noted above, that they are entitled to the immediate possession thereof; that it has a good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid; that it will and its successors and assigns shall, warrant and defend the same to the said GRANTEES, their heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims of all persons.

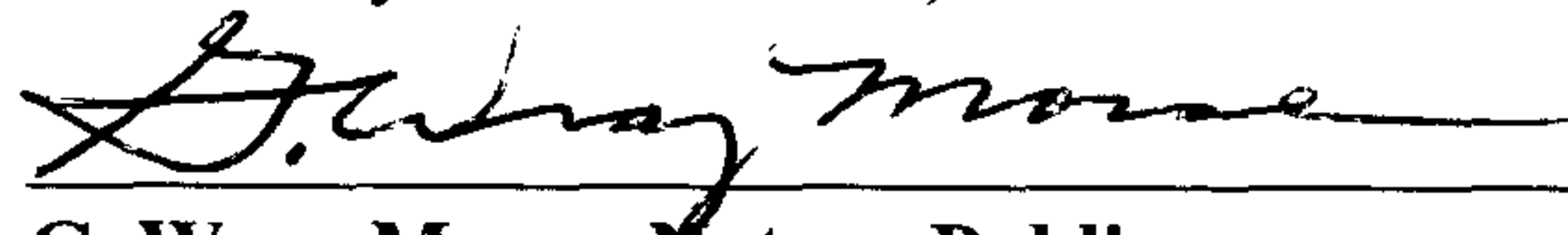
