

Mayor Roy introduced the following Ordinance:

## ORDINANCE NO. 2004-05

WHEREAS, on or about the 5<sup>th</sup> day of January 2004, George W. Roy, Mayor of the City of Calera filed a petition with the City Clerk of the City of Calera, Alabama as required by 11-42-20 and 11-42-21, Code of Alabama 1975, as amended, petitioning and requesting that the property hereinafter described be annexed to the municipality of the City of Calera, Alabama, which petition contained an accurate description of the property proposed to be annexed together with a map of the said property showing its relationship to the corporate limits of the City of Calera, Alabama, and the signature of the owner of the property described were signed thereto;

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALERA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the City of Calera, Alabama does adopt this Ordinance assenting to the annexation of the property owned by the above referenced property owner, as described in:

to the municipality of the City of Calera, Alabama.

- 2. That the corporate limits of the City of Calera, Alabama, be extended and rearranged so as to embrace and include such property, and such property shall become a part of the corporate area of such municipality upon the date of publication or posting of this Ordinance, as provided for in the Code of Alabama as cited above.
- 3. That the City Clerk be and she is hereby authorized and directed to file a copy of this ordinance, including an accurate description of the property being annexed, together with a map of the said property showing its relationship to the corporate limits of the City of Calera, Alabama, to which said property is being annexed in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama.

4. That the Zoning Map of the City of Calera, Alabama and any other official maps or surveys of the City shall be amended to reflect the annexation of the above described property, and that a copy of this Ordinance be transmitted to the City Planning Commission and the Zoning Administrator.


#### City of Calera

#### Northend Wastewater Treatment Plant

A parcel of land containing 20.575 Acres (896,251.276 Square Feet) being the West Half of the SE ¼ of the NW ¼ of Section 36, Township 21 South, Range 2 West, being more particularly described as follows:

Commence and Begin at a three inch capped pipe found at the Northwest corner of the SE ¼ of the NW ¼ of Section 36, Township 21 South, Range 2 West; thence run an assumed bearing of North 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds. East a distance of 668.09 feet to a ½ inch capped pipe set (Embosses "CARR 00010 LS"); thence South 01 deg. 22 min. 13 sec. East a distance of 1341.64 feet to a ½ inch capped pipe set at the South line of the SE ¼ of the NW ¼ of Section 36, Township 21 South, Range 2 West; thence North 89 deg. 58 min. 11 sec. West along said South line a distance of 668.53 feet to a ½ inch capped pipe set at the Southwest corner of the SE ¼ of the NW ¼ of Section 36, Township 21 South, Range 2 West; thence North 01 deg. 21 min. 07 sec. West along the West line of the SE ¼ of the NW ¼ of Section 36, Township 21 South, Range 2 West a distance of 1341.28 feet to the Point of Beginning.

SUBJECT TO any rights claimed by others for that property West of a North-South running fence line that exist approximately 35 feet East of and parallel to the West line of the above described property and a 1 and ½ inch pipe found near the South end of that fence.
