ORDER

THIS CAUSE, coming on to be heard was submitted upon the Defendant's Petition for Modification of Divorce, Plaintiff's Answer and Counter Petition for Modification of Divorce, Petition for Rule Nisi and Petition for Protection From Abuse, on this the 28TH day of May, 2001, and both parties being present with their respective attorneys, and based upon the agreement reached between the parties and testimony having been taken in Open Court, the Court is of the opinion that the following Order should be entered.

It is therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED:**

CHILD SUPPORT

1. That the paragraph entitled "Support" of the Final Judgment of Divorce rendered in this cause on September 6, 2001, is hereby modified as follows:

"SUPPORT: The Husband shall pay to the Wife the sum of \$287.69 per month for the support and maintenance of the minor child of the parties."

INCOME WITHHOLDING ORDER

2. Reference is hereby made to a separate Order entitled Order of Continuing Income Withholding for Support, pursuant to Title 30-3-60, Code of Alabama, 1975, which is specifically incorporated herein as a part of this Court's Order in this cause, which shall be filed

with the Court and served on the Defendant's employer, Cummins Alabama, Inc., 2200 Pinson Valley Parkway, Tarrant, Alabama 35217.

3. That the Defendant is currently in arrears in child support in the amount of Seven-Hundred Sixty-Four and No/100 Dollars (\$764.00). Counsel for the Defendant is to forward a draft drawn from his trust account to counsel for the Plaintiff in the above-stated amount. Said draft is to be mailed on or before May 29, 2002.

TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

4. The Court hereby makes reference to a Temporary Restraining Order entered on January 18, 2002. Said Order is to remain in full force and effect for six (6) months from the date of the entry of this Order.

ATTORNEY'S FEES

5. The Defendant shall pay to the Plaintiff for her use and benefit in paying her Attorney of Record for services rendered in this cause the sum of One Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$1,000.00) within sixty (60) days from the date of the entry of this Order. This obligation shall be satisfied by making payment directly to Attorney Josh J. Mitchell at his office address of 2017 Second Avenue North, First Floor, Birmingham, Alabama 35203.

6. That the rest and remainder of the Agreement incorporated into and made a part of the Final Judgement of Divorce entered on the 6th day of September, 2001, is hereby ratified and shall remain in full force and effect other than as set out herein.

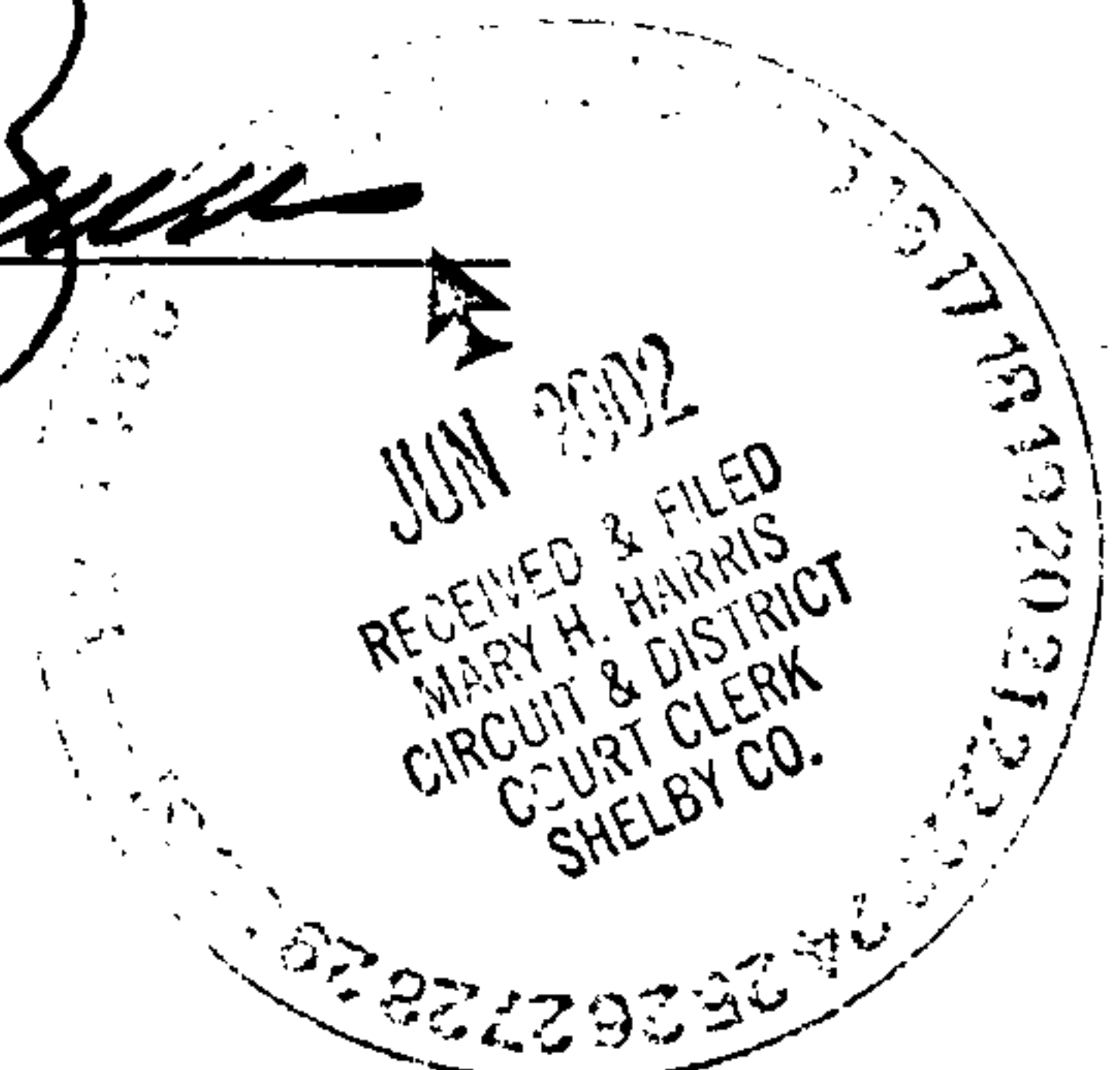
