AFFIDAVIT

BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, in and for said county and said state personally came and appeared **ROBERT S. CANAVERA**, who, after having first duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. My name is **ROBERT S. CANAVERA** and I am employed by United States Steel Corporation, a Delaware corporation, successor (by conversion) to United States Steel LLC and remote successor to USX Corporation (hereinafter referred to as "U.S. Steel") as a forester. I have been employed by U.S. Steel as a forester for approximately 31 years.
2. During my employment with U.S. Steel I have been involved with reviewing and maintaining the real property records of U.S. Steel for their lands in Alabama.
3. From the records maintained by U.S. Steel, I prepared the various legal descriptions for that sale to RGGS Land & Minerals, Ltd., L.P., a Delaware Limited Partnership, of certain real property interests, including all mineral interests, owned by U.S. Steel in Alabama (the "Subject Property"). The effective date of this sale is January 1, 2003.
4. I prepared the legal descriptions using the most current information available. In certain instances, the most current information may vary from the historical information in U.S. Steel's records. In those instances the most current information was used as it was determined to be more precise.
5. The legal descriptions were prepared with the intent and understanding that U.S. Steel conveyed all mineral interests, and various other interests, in Alabama, to RGGS Land & Minerals, Ltd., L.P.


