An cle VI Section 7. APPOINTMENT OF ATTORNEYS-IN-FACT, ETC. "The chairman of the board, the president, any vice-president, the secretary or any assistant secterary of each of these Companies shall be and is hereby vested with full power and authority to appoint anomeys-in-fact for the purpose of signing the name of the Companies as surely to, and to execute, attach the corporate seal, acknowledge and deliver any and all bonds, recognizances, stipulations, undertakings or other instruments of surely-slip and policies of insurance to be given in favor of any individual, firm, corporation, or the official representative thereof, or to any country or state, or the United States of America, or to any other political subdivision."
