

Mayor Roy introduced the following Ordinance:

ORDINANCE NO. 2004-22

WHEREAS, on or about the 31st day of March 2004, Abdul R. Ali filed a petition with the City Clerk of the City of Calera, Alabama as required by 11-42-20 and 11-42-21, Code of Alabama 1975, as amended, petitioning and requesting that the property hereinafter described be annexed to the municipality of the City of Calera, Alabama, which petition contained an accurate description of the property proposed to be annexed together with a map of the said property showing its relationship to the corporate limits of the City of Calera, Alabama, and the signature of the owner of the property described were signed thereto;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALERA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the City of Calera, Alabama does adopt this Ordinance assenting to the annexation of the property owned by the above referenced property owner, as described in:

Exhibit A

to the municipality of the City of Calera, Alabama.

2. That the corporate limits of the City of Calera, Alabama, be extended and rearranged so as to embrace and include such property, and such property shall become a part of the corporate area of such municipality upon the date of publication or posting of this Ordinance, as provided for in the Code of Alabama as cited above.

3. That the City Clerk be and she is hereby authorized and directed to file a copy of this ordinance, including an accurate description of the property being annexed, together with a map of the said property showing its relationship to the corporate limits of the City of Calera, Alabama, to which said property is being annexed in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama.

4. That the Zoning Map of the City of Calera, Alabama and any other official maps or surveys of the City shall be amended to reflect the annexation of the above described property, and that a copy of this Ordinance be transmitted to the City Planning Commission and the Zoning Administrator.

Council Member Phillips moved that unanimous consent of the Council be given for the immediate action upon said Ordinance. Council Member Davis seconded said motion and upon vote the results were:

Said property is described in the attached Exhibit A.

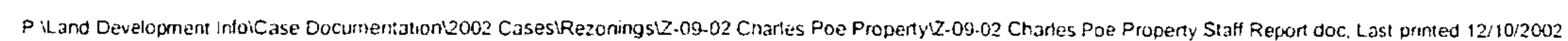

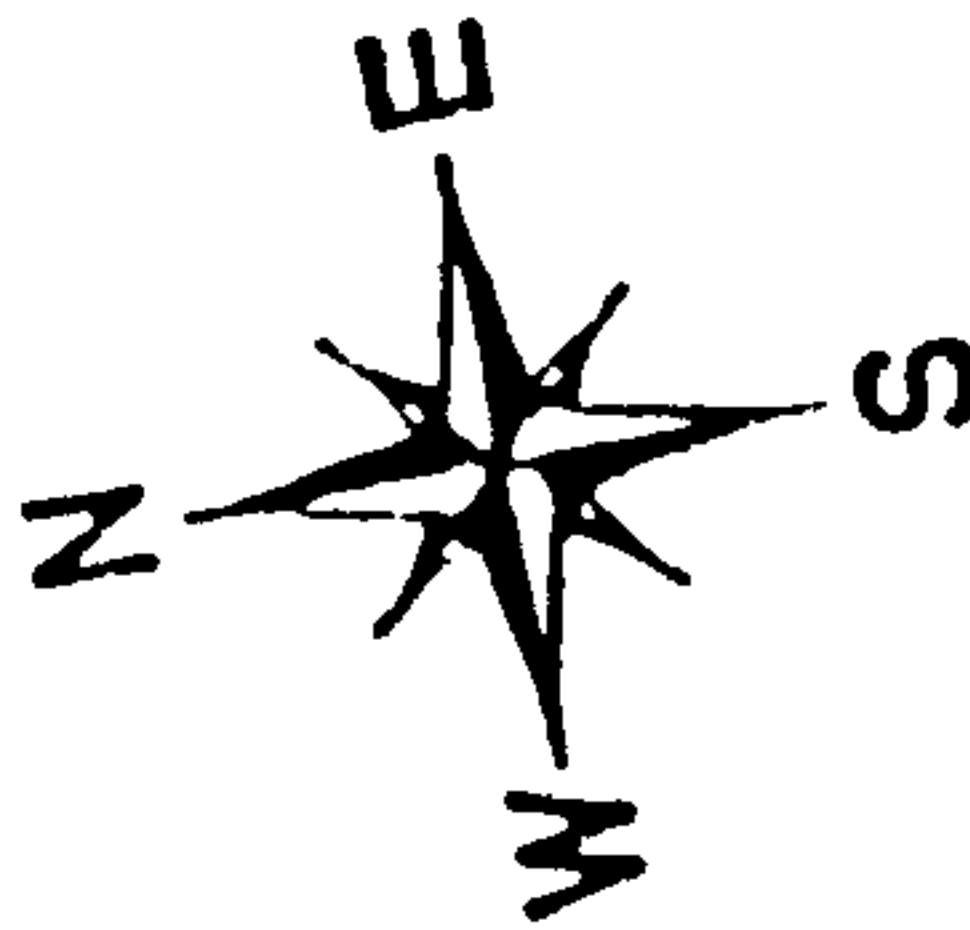

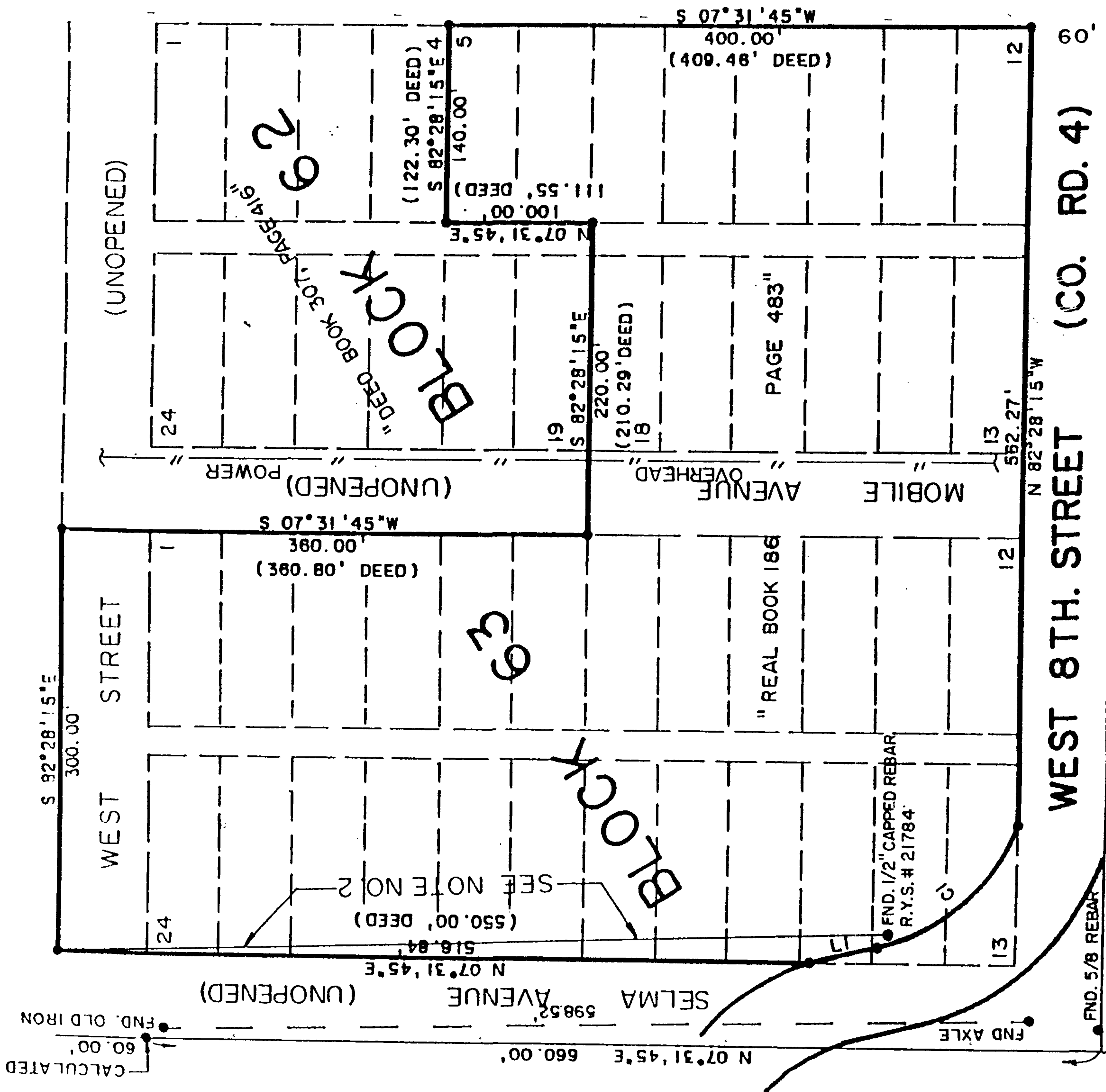
Begin at a 5/8" rebar at the Southeast Corner of Lot No. 12, Block No. 62 According to the map Of South Calera as recorded in Map Book 3, Page 40, Shelby County, Alabama; thence along the south line of Block No. 62 and its extension thereof into Block No. 63 and run N 82°28'15"W for 562.27 feet to a 5/8" rebar at the beginning of a non-radial curve to the right having a central angle of 57°05'42" and a radius of 135.78 feet; thence along the chord of said curve N 34°22'22" W and run a chord distance of 129.77 feet to the end of said curve, said point being radial to the radius point of said curve; thence along the "current right-of-way line" of County Road No. 4 N 05°49'32"W and run 47.87 feet to a 5/8 " rebar on the east line of Selma Avenue as shown upon said map or plat South Calera; thence along said east line of Selma Avenue N 07°31'45"E and run 516.84 feet to a 5/8" rebar on the north line of West Street as shown upon said map or plot of South Calera; thence along the north line of said West Street 82°28'15"E and run 300.00 feet to a 5/8" rebar; thence S 07°31'45"W and run across said West Street and along the east line of Block No. 63 for 360.00 feet to a 5/8 " rebar; thence S 82°28'15"E and run 220.00 feet to a 5/8" rebar on the Southwest Corner of Lot No. 6, Block No. 62 according to said map or plat of South Calera; thence N 07°31'45"E and run 100.00 feet to a 5/8' rebar at the Northwest Corner of Lot No. 5 according to said map or plat of South Calera; thence S 82°28'15"E and run 140.00 feet to a 5/8" rebar on the west right-of-way line of U.S. Highway No. 31; thence along said right-of-way line S 07°31'45"W and run 400.00 feet back to the Point Of Beginning. Containing 7.25 acres, more or less.
