Part of Lot 4-A, Resurvey of Lots 2, 3 & 4 Weatherly Commercial Subdivision as recorded in the Office of the Judge of Probate, Shelby County, Alabama in Map Book 23, Page 20, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of said Lot 4-A, run in a Northerly direction along the East line of said Lot 4-A for a distance of 375.0 feet to an existing iron rebar set by Laurence D. Weygand; thence turn an angle to the left of 94 degrees 07 minutes 35 seconds and run in a Westerly direction for a distance of 27.56 feet to an existing iron set by Laurence D. Weygand; thence turn an angle to the left of 38 degrees 30 minutes 31 seconds and run in a Southwesterly direction for a distance of 109.07 feet to an existing iron rebar set by Laurence D. Weygand and being on a curve, said curve being concave in a Southwesterly direction and having a deflection angle of 9 degrees 47 minutes 07 seconds and a radius of 350.09 feet; thence turn an angle to the left (67 degrees 20 minutes 27 seconds to the chord of said curve) and run in a Southeasterly direction along the arc of said curve and along the West line of said Lot 4-A for a distance of 119.58 feet to the point of ending of said curve and being on the Northeast right of way line of Weatherly Club Drive; thence run in a Southeasterly direction along line tangent to the end of said curve and along the Northeast right of way line of said Weatherly Club Drive for a distance of 190.29 feet to an existing iron rebar set by Laurence D. Weygand and being the Southwest corner of said Lot 4-A; thence turn an angle to the left of 79 degrees 47 minutes 10 seconds and run in an Easterly direction along the South line of said Lot 4-A for a distance of 33.41 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.
