DOMESTIC NON-PROFIT CORPORATION ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION GUIDELINES

INSTRUCTIONS:

Step 1: This form is a guideline for completing your Articles of Incorpation. To incorporate, file the original and two copies of the Articles of Incorporation in the county where the corporation's registered office is located. The Secretary of State's filing fee is \$20. Please contact Judge of Probate to verify filing fees. Step 2: Non-profit corporations MUST have at least three directors.

Pursuant to the provisions of the Alabama Non-Profit Corporation Act, the undersigned hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

Article I	The name of the corporation: Stables
Article II	The duration of the corporation is perpetual, unless otherwise stated.
Article III	The corporation has been organized for the following purpose(s): Care of horses, Maintaining harn and pastures
Article IV	10-3A-26. A corporation may have one or more classes of members or may have no members. If the corporation has one or more members, the designation of such class or classes, the manner of election or appointment and the qualification and rights of the members of each class shall be set forth in the articles of incorporation. No members. To members. If the corporation has no members, that fact shall be set forth in the articles of incorporation.
