

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

LaRue, Inc.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Alabama Business Corporation Act, hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation;

ARTICLE ONE

NAME

Name. The name of the corporation is LaRue, Inc.

ARTICLE TWO

PURPOSES, FOREIGN BUSINESS, AND DURATION

Purposes. The purpose or purposes for which the Corporation is organized are to engage in all other legal business, and to do everything necessary, proper, advisable, or convenient for the accomplishment of the foregoing purposes, and to do all things incidental to them or connected with them that are nor forbidden by law or by these Articles of Incorporation.

Conducting Business in Other Jurisdictions. The Corporation may conduct business and otherwise carry out its purposes and exercise its powers in any state, territory, district, or possession of the United States, or in any foreign county, to the full extent permitted by the laws of the state, territory, district, or possession of the United States, or by the foreign county; and it may limit its purpose or purposes in any state, territory, district, or possession of the United States, or foreign country.

Period of Duration. The period of duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE THREE

ARTICLE FOUR

CAPITAL STOCK

Number of Authorized Shares and Par Value. The aggregate number of shares that the corporation shall have authority to issue is 100 shares of common stock with a par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share.

ARTICLE FIVE

DIRECTORS

Number of Directors. The Board of Directors of the Corporation shall consist of 1 members, who need not to be residents of any particular state or shareholders of the Corporation. The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time by amendment of this Section of these Articles of Incorporation, but no decrease shall have the effect of shortening the term of any incumbent director. The affirmative vote of the holders of 5 percent of the issued and outstanding voting shares of the Corporation shall be required to amend this Section of these Articles of Incorporation.
