AFFIDAVIT AS TO DEATH AND HEIRS

Before me, the undersigned, a Notary Public in and for said County in said State, personally appeared JACK BRANTLEY whose name is signed to this Affidavit and who is known to me, and who, being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

My name is JACK BRANTLEY and I reside in Shelby County, Alabama. I was personally acquainted with REECIE MAJORS a/k/a WILLIAM R. MAJORS who died on or about MAY 20, 1971. He died intestate and there was no administration of his estate and he left no debts outstanding at the time of his death. During his lifetime he owned the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:

Commence at the Southeast corner of Section 8, Township 21 South, Range 3 West; thence run in a Westerly direction along said section line for 418.03 feet; thence run North 00 degrees 12 minutes 26 seconds West along the East right of way line of Brantlyville Road for 439 feet to a found 1" crimp iron and the point of beginning; thence run North 00 degrees 12 minutes 26 seconds West, along said right of way for 272.86 feet to a set 1/2" rebar; thence run North 89 degrees 41 minutes 55 seconds East for 95.00 feet to a found 1" open pipe; thence run South 00 degrees 21 minutes 28 seconds East for 272.86 feet to a found 1" open pipe; thence run South 89 degrees 41 minutes 55 seconds West for 95.72 feet to the point of beginning.

I had known REECIE MAJORS a/k/a WILLIAM R. MAJORS for a period of more than 20 years and knew his family. He left surviving him a widow, namely L. V. MAJORS a/k/a ELVEE MAJORS a/ka ELVEE RASCOE MAJORS, and four children, namely, MALCOLM WAYNE MAJORS, JOHN T. MAJORS, PATRICIA JACKS AND CAROLYN HOLSOMBACK. The said widow, L. V. MAJORS a/k/a ELVEE MAJORS a/k/a ELVEE RASCOE MAJORS, died on or about AUGUST 29, 1976 and she left a will which was never probated and there was no administration of her estate and she left no debts outstanding at the time of her death. The said REECIE MAJORS a/k/a WILLIAM R. MAJORS and L. V. MAJORS a/k/a ELVEE MAJORS a/k/a ELVEE RASCOE MAJORS also had one son, namely LARRY WAYNE MAJORS who died when he was only 1 day old in 1956. The said living children are over the age of 19 years and are of sound mind. Other
