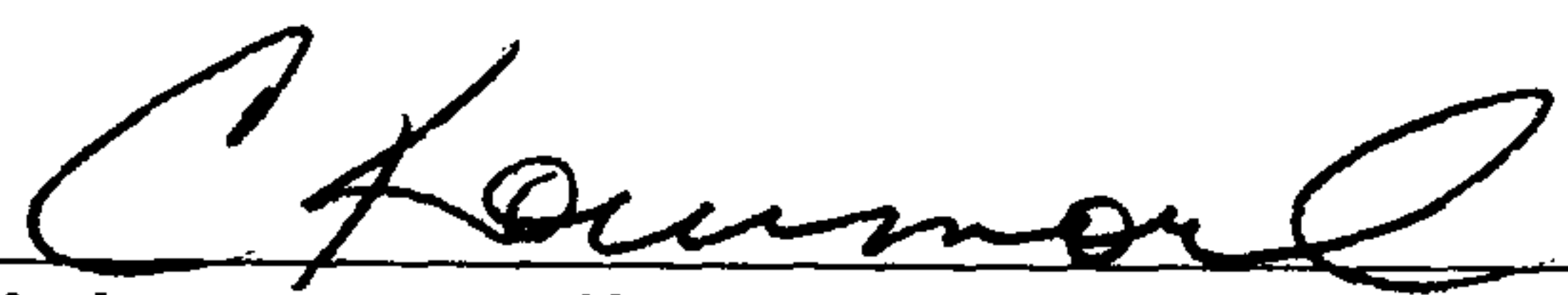


Articles of Incorporation
