WARRANTY DEED, JOINT TENANTS WITH RIGHT OF SURVIVORSHIP

That in consideration of **Three Hundred Twenty-Two Thousand Three Hundred Ninety and 00/100 Dollars (\$322,390.00)** to the undersigned grantors in hand paid by the grantees herein, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, we,

Stephen W. Glenn and his wife Maria M. Glenn

(hereinafter referred to as "Grantors") do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto

Bradley Sandidge and Rebecca Sandidge

(hereinafter referred to as "Grantees") as joint tenants with right of survivorship, the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Alabama to-wit:

Lot 46, according to the Survey of Oak Meadows, 2nd Sector, as recorded in Map Book 22, Page 79, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama

\$232,390.00 of the proceeds come from a mortgage recorded simultaneously herewith.


Subject to:


- (1) 2004 ad valorem taxes not yet due and payable;**
- (2) all mineral and mining rights not owned by the Grantors; and**
- (3) all easements, rights-of-way, restrictions, covenants and encumbrances of record.**

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD unto Grantees as joint tenants, with right of survivorship, their heirs and assigns, forever; it being the intention of the parties to this conveyance, that (unless the joint tenancy hereby created is severed or terminated during the joint lives of the grantees herein) in the event one grantee herein survives the other, the entire interest in fee simple shall pass to the surviving grantee, and if one does not survive the other, then the heirs and assigns of the grantees herein shall take as tenants in common.

And we do for ourselves and for our heirs, executors, and administrators covenant with Grantees, their heirs and assigns, that we are lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises; that they are free from all encumbrances, unless otherwise noted above; that we have a good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid; that we will and our heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to Grantees, their heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims of all persons.
