That said Old Cahaba Residential Association, Inc., claims a lien upon the following property, situated in Shelby County, Alabama to wit:

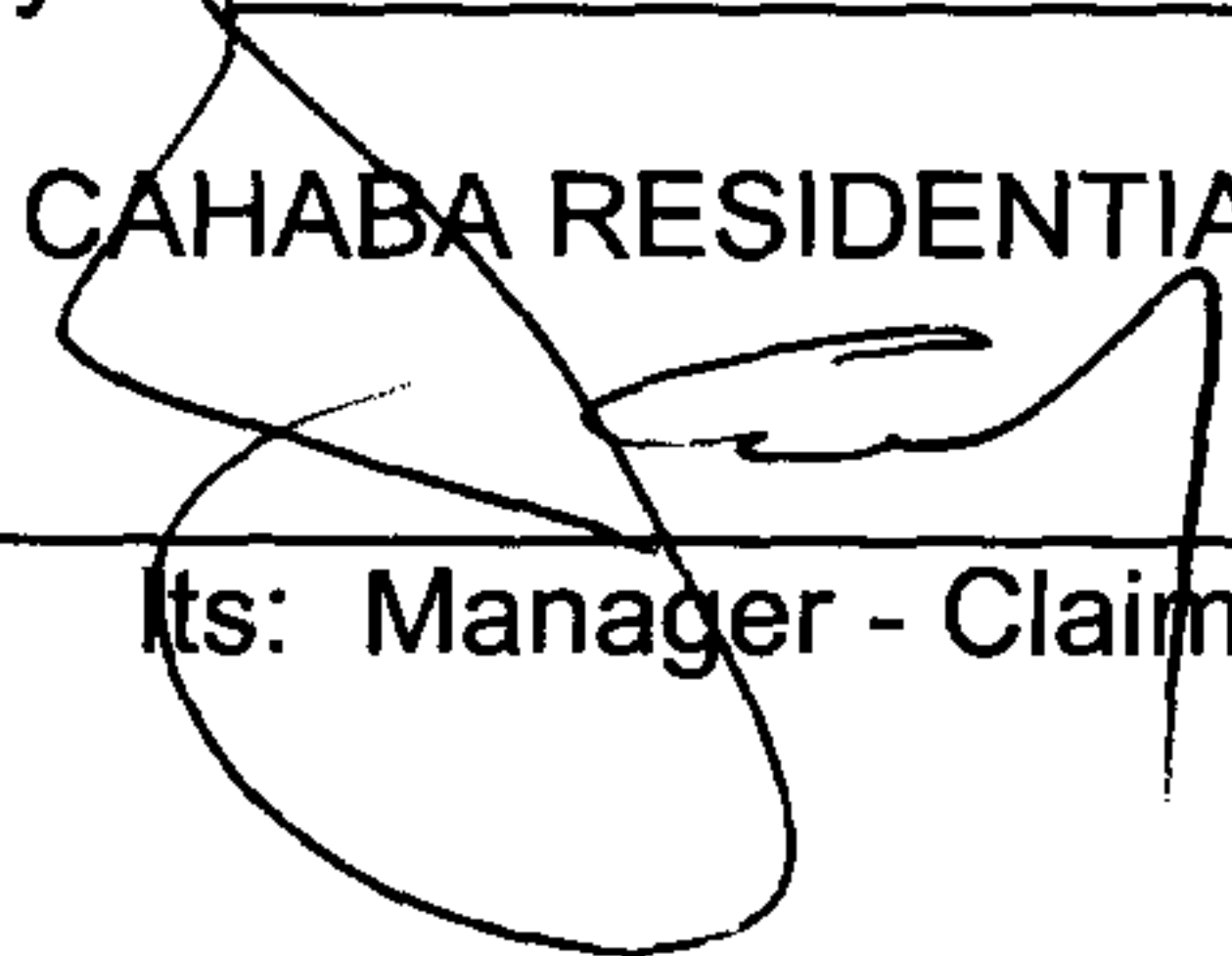

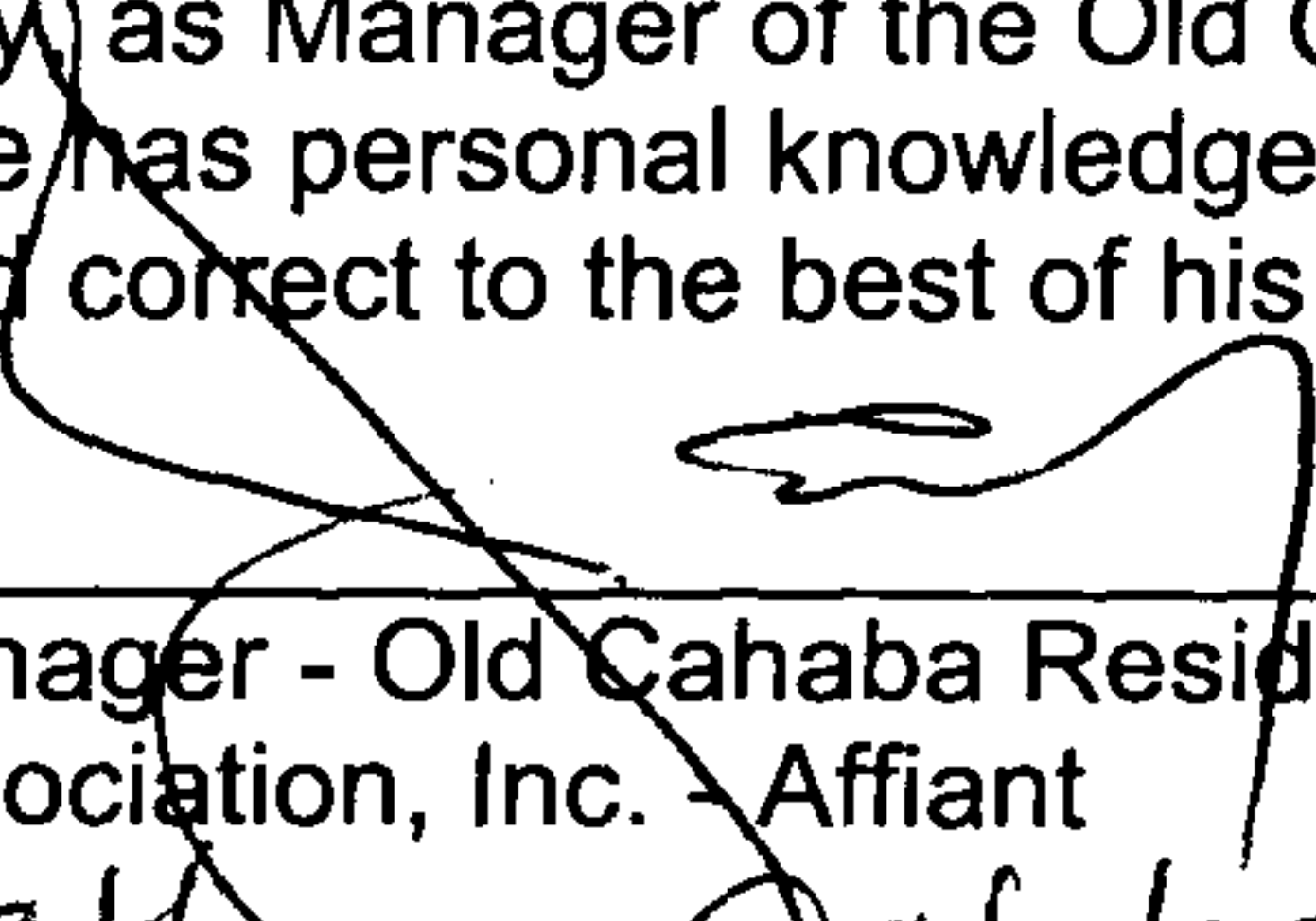
